Patrol Sponsors Aid Class

Willamette Ski patrol will hold first aid class for members of the patrol and interested skiers, with the class scheduled for 7:30 p.m. at the Community Center, 178 Willamette street, Leeson, member of the patrol will be instructor.

Atom Bomb Souvenir

CLAS—(P)—When the mayor received a small wooden box containing a souvenir of the atomic bomb, his office took possession of it. They called the chief of police.

The box arrived at the office of Woodall Rodgers yesterday afternoon. A notation on the box indicated it was delivered at 2:30 p. m., 1-19-46.

De's Suite No. 2 in B minor for strings and flute; Mozart's "Symphony (C major); Beethoven's Fifth symphony (C major); Brahms' First symphony (C major); Schumann's "Rhenish" symphony (Symphony No. 3 in E major); Cesar Franck's Symphony in D minor; Richard Strauss' rondo, "Till Eulenspiegel's Merry Pranks"; Stravinsky's "Petrouchka"; Debussy's "Afternoon of a Faun," and Shostakovich's Symphony No. 5, Opus 47.

De says also he considered the Gershwin "the great music America has produced."

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
