

1536 Job Applicants Registered in USES

Job applicants registered in the Eugene United States Employment Service Office active file for February, number 1536, reports Don-

ald E. Mattson, office manager. Mattson explained that the file includes all those who have been in the office within the month to register for unemployment compensation or to seek work. He pointed out that many of them may be and probably have been put back to work by obtaining jobs on their own or going back to their regular employment, but that the 1536 have not been placed through his office.

The employment situation is growing brighter, the manager said, with load of office calls reduced some 400 last week under the week before. Return to work in the woods and other jobs openings probably have taken some 400 names from the list, he predicted.

The load of office calls was at a low point, about 1750, shortly before Christmas, after the lumber strike was over and before the flood disrupted work, office calls rose to a peak of over 2600 a week, and the total has remained around that level until a week or two ago. Last week, however, it was below the December low point, in spite of the fact that there have been many servicemen coming back, the manager said.

A list of "active registered occupations" was published last month, and Mattson attributed to it the fact that such unusual skills as that of an X-ray technician and a baseball umpire were called for and the people placed. The former

went to work for a local doctor, the latter for the Southern league.

This month's list contains many logging and lumber workers, cannery workers and truck drivers, due to bad weather and seasonal closure of work. Many of the truck drivers, Mattson points out, are returning servicemen, who have had driving experience in their service duties.

The list contains such unusual and diverse applicants as a metal meteorologist, an inorganic chemist, material planner, gill net fisherman, garment machine operator. It follows:
