**Army Disregards Volunteers For Bikini Atomic Bomb Tests**

ROSWELL, N. M.—(AP)—Air Force officers preparing for the mid-Pacific test of an atomic bomb against a massed fleet of warships promised today they will completely ignore a flood of requests by persons volunteering to ride as passengers aboard the guinea pig fleet.

Col. Alfred Kalberer, chief of intelligence for the Air Force unit which will drop the atomic bomb at Bikini atoll in May, said the Army has decided not to take the atomic volunteers seriously.

"Some of them are publicity seekers," the Colonel said. "Others are convicts who want a pardon. And some of them are just plain nuts."

Kalberer said requests from volunteers who seek a fiery, atomic ride to death during "operation crossroads" began coming in after the disclosure that men and equipment were being assembled for the mid-Pacific test.

**Army Credits Germans For Bomb Research Aid**

WASHINGTON—(AP)—The War Department has credited German scientists with helping the U. S. Army develop rocket bombs "more effective than those with which the Nazis bombarded London and other European cities."

In a statement describing the activities of German technicians brought to this country, the Army said most of them are buzz bomb experts. Others are working at undisclosed places on jet-propelled planes and aerodynamic research, and a few are engaged in "several additional fields of military research."

**KLINGLING HERO DIES**

LONDON—(AP)—Maj. Gen. L. C. Dunsterville, 80, the original "Stinky" of Rudyard Kipling's famous "Stalky and Co.," died Sunday at Torquay on the English Channel, it was learned. Dunsterville was the last survivor of the book's schoolboy trio. Kipling himself was the original of "beetle" and the late G. C. Beresford was "in Turk."

**Roseburg Dairymen Vote To Increase Prices**

ROSEBURG, March 21—(AP)—Butterfat prices will be increased in the Roseburg delivery area from 92 cents to \$1.15 a pound on March 25 whether the OPA grants such a boost or not. This was the announcement here today of Louis Nichols, president of the Douglas County Milk Producers Assn., following a meeting last night at which the increase was unanimously voted.

Nichols explained that the price boost was favored as against cessation of delivery to consumers and which would have constituted a strike against the government.

"We are tired of being given the run-around by the OPA," Nichols said. "If it doesn't approve of the price increase and decides to penalize us—we'll they can't put all of us in jail."

**German Black Marketeers Steal Trainload of Coal**

HERFORD—(AP)—The black market is so cleverly organized in Germany now that a gang was able to steal an entire trainload of coal in the Ruhr, transport it 200 miles to Aurich near the North Sea and swap it for potatoes.

This flagrant case was disclosed by a British military government officer whose position forbids his quotation by name.

The officer said the remarkable theft of hundreds of tons of coal was only one example of the "brains" behind the black market.

Many Connections  
"Obviously these gangs are reaching into high railroad circles," he said. "They must have connections with Germans who have been retained to run the rails."

Illicit trading had reached such proportions that British occupation authorities have set up special teams of police, working with Germans, in concentrated efforts to trap the ring leaders.
