 ber of Commerce here will ad...
 vance money to the city to help...
 pay for installation of street lights...
 at Fifth and Main streets, if suf...
 ficient funds cannot be obtained...
 from other sources, Don Lane...
 Chamber manager, reports.

This decision was made Wed...
 nesday, Lane said, when the...
 Chamber reviewed a State High...
 way Commission recommendation...
 that street and pedestrian lights...
 be installed at the intersection...
 which also is part of State High...
 way 28.
 The proposed lights would cost...
 approximately \$1600, it was point...
 ed out at a special meeting last...
 Thursday of the City Council. Of...
 this the city's share would be...
 about \$800.

The City has \$375 for lights.
 This amount was allowed in the...
 revised budget passed by Spring...
 field voters in a special city elec...
 tion June 26. A larger amount was...
 voted down with the rejection of...
 the first budget at the May 17...
 primaries.

Even if the Chamber advances...
 the \$425 needed and the lights are...
 installed, maintenance must be...
 paid out of city funds.
