Bilbo Draws Opposition

LOUISVILLE, Ky.—(AP)—Petitions to unseat Senator Bilbo (D-Miss), to "outlaw the Ku Klux Klan in the United States" and to pass a federal anti-lynching law have been signed by several hundred physicians attending the convention of the National Negro Medical Assn. here.

The petitions were circulated at the convention session Tuesday by Edgar G. Brown of Washington, director of the National Negro Council. He said they already had been signed by 400,000 persons all over the country.

One of the petitions, criticizing Bilbo's recent radio broadcast in which he urged "red-blooded Anglo-Saxons in Mississippi to resort to any means to keep all Negroes from voting in the primary election," asks that the U. S. Senate deny a seat to Bilbo for "disorderly behavior."

UO Reports Staff Addition

Dr. Joel V. Berreman has been named associate professor of sociology at the University of Oregon, according to an announcement made this week. The appointment is subject to confirmation by the State Board of Higher Education.

Dr. Berreman has worked for the past four years in government service with OWI and other war agencies, serving part of that time in China and India as propaganda analyst.

The sociologist received his baccalaureate degree from Willamette University in Salem in 1927 and in 1933, received a master's degree from the University of Oregon. Stanford University awarded his doctoral degree in 1940.

During the period from 1933 to 1934 he was a teaching assistant in sociology at Stanford, and from 1934 to 1935 was an instructor in citizenship at the same university. In 1935 he went to Washington State College as an instructor in sociology and after one year, returned to Stanford to hold the same position until 1940 when he was made an assistant professor. He went to Washington State College in February of this year as an associate professor.

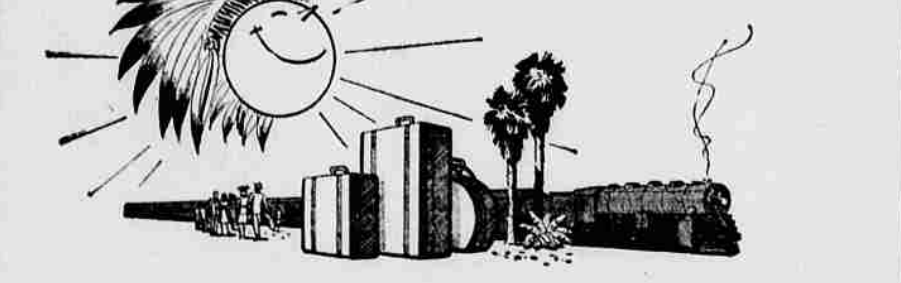
