

Great Lakes Ship Route Subsidizing
 The CIO National Maritime Union directed members to return to work aboard five vessels of the Standard Oil Company of Indiana Friday following ratification of an agreement calling for a work week of 48 hours at sea and 44 hours in port.

Joseph Curran, NMU president, said the agreement had been ratified by a majority of the 2500 union members in 18 Great Lakes ports.

A similar agreement was reached with Bethlehem Transportation Co. and will be submitted to the union membership for ratification, Curran said. He added that the NMU is "in consultation with" other strike-bound lake operators but declined to name them.

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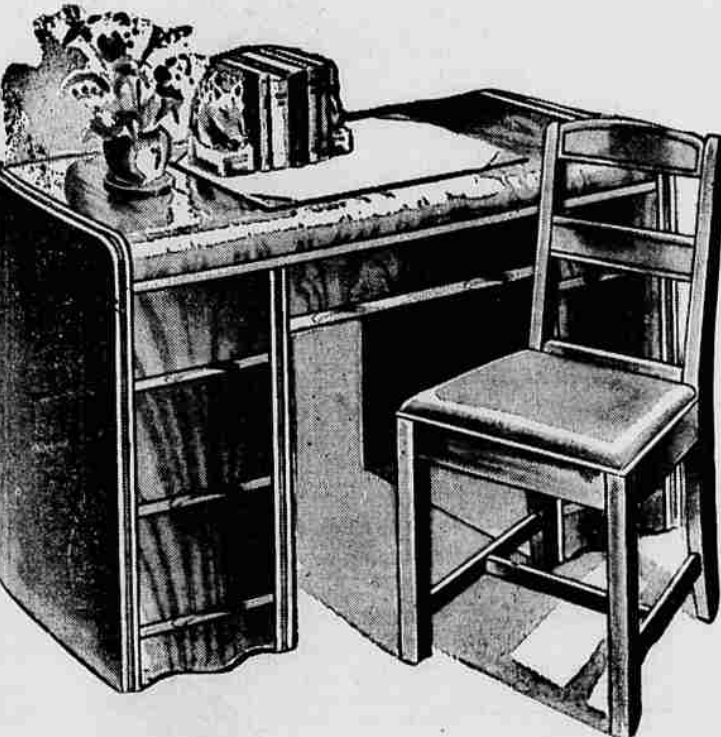

Apprenticeship Council Passes 62 Agreements; Method Told

Sixty-two apprenticeship agreements were considered and passed by the Eugene Apprenticeship Council at its last meeting, it was reported here Thursday.

Within the past few months, the council has promoted four apprentices to journeymen, and within the next two months there will be approximately 10 more ready to complete their training and take their examinations.

Chester F. Lee, carpenter, one of the 700 apprentices set up in training under direction of the Eugene vocational school during the past year, completed his training and was promoted to journeyman status this month. The certificate of completion of apprenticeship is recognized in any state of the union and in Canada.

Open to All

Apprenticeship training is available to anyone in the Eugene area. It is pointed out, however, that most of the apprentices set up in "on-the-job" training at present are veterans under the GI Bill of Rights.

Within the Eugene area there are over 50 different occupations listed as offering trainees "on-the-job" training, and there are nearly twice that number of actual job classifications within these occupations.

Unemployment Figure Drops

Only about 100 persons in this area drew unemployment insurance during the past week, and the figure is expected to drop even lower as hop, bean and other harvests reach a climax early in September, according to Silas Gaiser, administrator of the State Unemployment Commission at Salem.

Claims in this part of the state were about equally divided into four groups: shipyards, logging and lumber products, trade and service, and cannery, construction and other manufacturing.

Slightly more than 100 each were being paid last week from the Toledo, Salem and Coos Bay offices, while Klamath Falls, McMinville and Astoria were on a par with Eugene.

Of the 8,057 Oregon residents who received unemployment compensation last week only 1193, or one in seven, live outside the Portland-Oregon City area.

In the metropolitan area, out of 6,864 claimants, nearly two thirds were former shipyard workers, while trade, finance, utilities and service accounted for one sixth. The remaining sixth came from construction, lumber, cannery and other industries.
