Eugene, but the city of Eugene is
contributing to the increase,
Chief L. L. Pittenger said
in comparing this year's
records with those of last year.
Records show that with-
out Eugene there have
been less traffic injuries ar-
rived with the first nine
months of 1945. There were 135
injuries during the first nine
months of 1945, 132 during the
same period in 1946.
The city has remained the
same with only three during the
first nine months of both years.
Chief said Gov. Earl Snell
was impressed by the city traf-
fic record that he complimented
Eugene during his attendance at
Homecoming football game.
John Matthews of the office of
secretary of state in Salem

Weeks Claim Victory
Over Leftists' Forces
ATHENS—(AP)—The Ministry
of Public Order announced Mon-
day that three battalions of gen-
darmes and soldiers wrested the
village of Vrontou, 15 miles south-
west of Athens, from leftist forces
after a 12-hour struggle
which 22 Leftists were killed.
The village, which has a popu-
lation of 639, was defended by 300
Leftists, said the ministry. Short-
ly before the government troops
moved into Vrontou the Leftists set
fire to the village.

Hess' Memory Returns
Gallows Fear Gone
BERNBERG—(AP)—Col. B. C.
Hess, U. S. commandant of
Bernberg prison, said Monday
that Rudolf Hess, no longer in the
shadow of the gallows, has staged
a remarkable recovery from the
trauma of memory of which he com-
plained during his trial.
Hess' former "deputy fuhrer,"
now serving a life term for war
crimes, "is in a good humor and
has a keen, alert memory," said
Hess.
Hess is listed as "convict 125."
