

Trips to Chicago Awarded to Two

One of the most successful 4-H seasons in many years has culminated in the awarding of trips to the National 4-H Club Congress Dec. 1-5 in Chicago to Jimmy Brougher, Goshen, and Betty Peterson, Noti, it was announced Wednesday by

E. A. Danielson, county 4-H Club agent.

In addition to the two trips awarded, there is a possibility of a third for Barbara Bloom, Crow, who won top state honors with her frozen foods and whose records have been passed on to the sectional contest to compete for the Chicago trip.

Miss Peterson won the award for her records which were entered in the clothing contest while Brougher took top state honors in farm crops and will enter his records at the Chicago congress, which this year is celebrating its twenty-fifth anniversary.

In addition to her chance at the Chicago trip, Miss Bloom won a \$50 savings bond.

Shirley Arne of Cottage Grove was awarded a \$25 bond for her victory garden entry along with a county medal. Other bond and medal winners are Marjorie Flanagan, Junction City, Class A, dairy production; Wayne Ross, Blachly, poultry; and Brandon Lyon, Junction City, Class B, dairy production.

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Aluminum Plant Seen in Portland

PORTLAND.—(AP)—An aluminum fabrication plant of Kaiser Co., Inc., employing 3000 to 5000 workers, will be established at the war-built Swan Island shipyard if satisfactory lease arrangements are made with the War Assets Administration, the Oregonian said Wednesday.

Edgar F. Kaiser, wartime manager of all Kaiser operations in Portland and Vancouver, Wash., told the Oregonian in a telephone interview Tuesday night that abandonment of the plan to lease the Richmond, Calif., No. 3 yard meant transfer of company plans to Portland.

"It is a definite possibility that we might bring an aluminum bus body plant to Swan Island," Kaiser said, "but it is a fact that we will bring some sort of aluminum fabrication plant there if a satisfactory lease is negotiated with the War Assets Administration by Dec. 1."

Kaiser did not elaborate on what the firm would fabricate beyond mention of the bus bodies, but said it was necessary to decide on some spot for development of enterprises in, order to hold together the management and engineering organization.

Good Location

"The proximity of Swan Island to our Trentwood aluminum rolling mill in Spokane makes the Portland location a natural for an aluminum fabrication plant," Kaiser said.

Referring to the estimated size of the payroll, Kaiser said "I recall that once I came to Portland talking of 7500 employees and ended up with 80,000."

citizens must do their share."

The colonel referred then to the State Armory Bill which will be placed before voters on the Nov. 5 ballot, providing for construction of 22 new armories in cities having none, and for repair, modernization and enlargement of existing armories. None of the 18 existing armories in the state will qualify without repairs and other work, the colonel declared, and this work must be done to meet the needs of the new National Guard.

The State Armory Bill will raise about \$500,000 a year by means of a .045 mill tax for the next 10 years. During this period, the federal government will pay to Lane County troops more than \$1,865,000. Thereafter this income will continue to come to the county as long as the National Guard is in existence.

Under the reorganization, units allotted Lane County will include the following: To Eugene, the old "C" Company, 162nd Infantry, 185 men; the old Medical detachment, 188th Infantry, 115 men; a new "C" Company, 162nd Engineers, 41st Division, 184 men; new Headquarters and Headquarters detachment, 171st Coast Artillery Battalion, 58 men; and 872nd anti-motor torpedo boat battery, Coast Artillery, 93 men. To Cottage Grove, a new Cannon Company, 162nd Infantry, making a total of 81 men; to Springfield, "K" Company, 162nd Infantry, formerly at Tillamook, totaling 195 men.

Federal payrolls to these seven units for attendance at weekly drills and at summer training pe-

riods are estimated at \$186,504 a year, of which \$128,797 will go to Eugene troops, \$40,740 to Springfield, and \$18,968 to Cottage Grove.
