The general school holiday Monday, which will permit students of School District Four to "sleep in" an extra day following their regular weekend reprieve, will apply to all public and parochial students in grade and high schools.

Planners Take Zoning Action

The Eugene city planning commission denied seven rezoning applications, approved two and tabled two applications at its meeting here Wednesday night.

It took action as follows on 11 rezoning applications:
Roy E. Pierson, 1308 E. 11th Ave. W., denied, after 20 persons presented a petition in opposition to application for change from residential to light industrial; Okay Rezoning

Mrs. A. L. Dorsey, 1528 Charnelton St., approved application for rezoning from single to multiple family residential. In connection with Mrs. Dorsey's application the commission recommended to the council that it rezone to multiple family the following area: between Fourteenth and Sixteenth Aves. W. and the alley between Olive and Charnelton Sts. on the east and the alley between Lincoln and Lawrence Sts. on the west; Shannon McKeown, 434 Harris St., denied application for change from residential to business. McKeown wanted to construct a store; Approve Duplex

Gale Roberts, Twenty-third and Alder Sts., approved application to rezone from single to multiple family. Roberts will build a duplex; Roy Pierce, 708 Monroe St., denied application to rezone from single family to light industrial. Pierce wanted to use property for cabinet shop; Deny Application

L. H. Mulkey, 1471 Jefferson St., single to multiple family for a rooming house, denied; Ted B. Law, corner of Thirteenth and Agate St., denied change from single family to business to be used as a commercial advertising studio; Mabel Hise, 1168 Sixth Ave. W., denied application to change from single to multiple family to be utilized for trailer house; Table Application

R. N. Garrison, tabled application for change from single family to business, but the commission recommended that the council change the entire one-half of Block 8, Chambers Addition, in which Garrison's property is located; Freightway Terminal Co., tabled application to rezone property at First and Jackson Sts. from single to light industrial after 20 property owners signed petition opposing the change; Paul P. Stewart, 2517 Potter St., denied change from single to multiple family.

State Ups Levy For Self-Insurance
SALEM—(AP)—The State Board of Control Thursday approved a levy of 22 cents per \$100 in value on all state activities to raise \$100,000 for the state restoration fund, which is the state's self-insurance system on its \$45,268,000 worth of property.

The levy is for the year which began last July 1. The fund now contains \$300,000. The board voted to assess the Canby, Mt. Angel and Springfield flax cooperative plants a total of \$1919 for the fund, or half the commercial insurance rate.

Graham Killam, Portland realtor, offered the board the Governor Building in Portland for \$250,000 for use as a state office building, but the board took no action. The five-story building is located at 2nd and Stark Streets.

Stained Cedar Shingles Get Increases in Price
WASHINGTON — (AP) — OPA Thursday granted a price increase of 60 cents per square on stained red cedar shingles, both individually and bundle dipped. The agency also authorized a price increase of 35 cents per square on stained red cedar machine processed shakes, a type of shingle used both for roofing and siding. The increases are to remain in effect for 60 days, after which prices will be subject to revision on the basis of information furnished by producers, OPA said.
