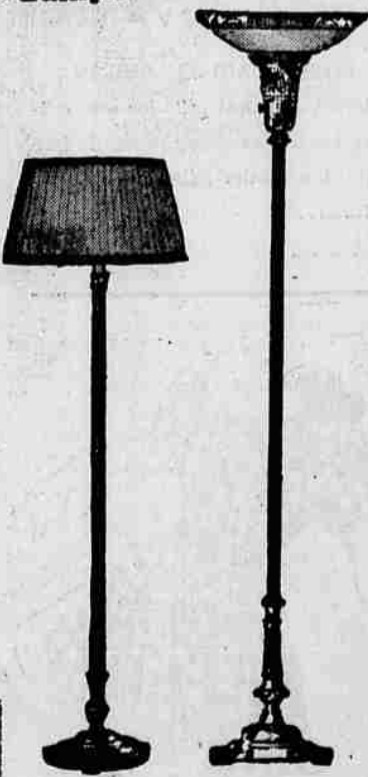

**Dairy Problems Report Finished**

Oregon's postwar dairy industry faces problems of more economical production, disease control and better marketing, which need both individual and concerted action for their solution, according to an analysis by a committee of the agricultural staff of Oregon State college.

Despite the present keen demand which exceeds supply for nearly all types of dairy products, the committee sees adjustments ahead which will require careful handling.

**Dried Milk**  
The development of the dried whole milk industry may be an important factor in dairy marketing during the next few years, the report states. Further improvement in the solubility and keeping qualities would make this product a direct competitor in the fluid and evaporated milk industries.

Improved quality of both butter and cheese will be necessary in future to hold markets once the present abnormal situation passes, committee members believe. Sales campaigns may be necessary to move these products in competition with substitutes offered at prices at which they can be produced.

**Gives Program**  
The analysis includes a suggested program based on better dairy stock, production testing, improved feed supply, disease control and improved quality, uniformity and packaging of dairy products.

The report, entitled "The Dairy Industry," may be obtained free from any extension office.

**Nicotine Dust Said Best Aphid Control**

Nicotine dusts are still the standard recommendation for control of hop aphids, though several of the newer chemical dusts have given promising results for use when nicotine is not readily available, according to a report on hop aphid research issued by the Oregon State College experiment station.

The recent scarcity of nicotine sulphate has created an acute problem among Oregon hop growers. This material has the advantage of killing the insects both by contact and by the fumes it gives off.

The newer insecticides tried in experiments over the past few years are purely contact killers, hence they have to be applied more thoroughly to the under side of the leaves.

Most of the machines now used by growers for dusting are not suitable for applying purely contact dusts, it was found. Aerosol generators have shown promising results with some of the new material but not with others.
