

### Red Cross to Assist Citizenship Seekers

Lane County Chapter of the American Red Cross is prepared

to assist alien servicemen and veterans in the county who wish to obtain United States citizenship under the Second War Powers Act of 1942, it was announced Thursday by Hugh McCallum, chairman.

The act, which expires Dec. 31, 1946, affects all aliens who enlisted or were inducted in the United States armed forces before Dec. 28, 1945, McCallum explained.

Those who apply before the deadline will avoid the necessity of filing customary declaration of intention or meeting the usual residential and language qualifications. They will also be exempt from educational tests and payment of a filing fee.

Alien servicemen or veterans who wish to take advantage of the opportunity should contact the local Red Cross chapter at 43 Eighth Ave. W. in Eugene at once.

### Oregon Farmers Asked to Raise High Quantity of Crops in 1947

Another year of high output from Oregon farms and ranches is called for in the state production goals for 1947, reports E. Harvey Miller, chairman of the state PMA committee. Total crop acres recommended for 1947 are about the same as this year, but sharp adjustments are asked for some crops.

The needs for meeting a strong domestic demand, for building reserves of some commodities and for some foods still badly needed to war-devastated countries have resulted in the call for a high 1947 output, Miller pointed out.

Final state goals which have been approved to date are as follows: Spring pigs, 25,000 sows to farrow, nine per cent increase from the 23,000 in 1946; rye, 38,000 acres, same as 1946; sugar beets, 22,000 acres, up 10 per cent from this year's record 20,000; dry peas, 22,000 acres (8000 smooth, 14,000 wrinkled), same as this year; Austrian peas, 25,000 acres, up 72 per cent from this

year's 14,500 acres; crimson clover, 2000 acres, down 13 per cent from the 2300 acres harvested 1946; hairy vetch, 55,000 acres, up 45 per cent from this year's 38,000 acres.

Some of the final goals for fall-seeded crops differ in the percentage change from 1946 from the goals announced earlier before planting time. This represents revisions in 1946 production figures, as suggested acreages for 1947 remain unchanged.

Suggested state goals submitted by the department of agriculture for other crops and commodities will be considered by the Oregon USDA council within the next few weeks, the PMA chairman said. These include dairy, livestock and poultry goals, barley, oats, hay, and hay and pasture crop seeds.
