**Drivers Face Snow Hazard**

Highway conditions in mountain areas remained hazardous Thursday, with the State Highway Commission warning that even worse conditions would prevail after heavy snows expected Thursday night.

Wednesday's blizzard at McKenzie summit left the highway packed with snow and slippery. Chains are required. A total of 38 inches of snow was recorded at Santiam summit, and light snow continued to fall Thursday.

At Willamette summit, it was reported snowing hard, with snow plows and sand crews operating. Six inches of new snow were recorded.

Chains are required for all mountain passes.
