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Ellsworth Tells of Responsibility Now Placed on Republicans

Speaking before the Young Republican Club at the Eugene Hotel Thursday evening, Representative Harris Ellsworth broke the wrapper off his views on the job now facing the Republican Party. He declared: "We're going to have to close our eyes to political considerations and pass what we think are the right laws for the problems now facing this country."

Pick Officers
Ellsworth's address followed the election of Young Republican officers for 1947. Those elected were: chairman, Bob Nielson; vice-chairman, Max Simpson; and secretary-treasurer, Betty Whitlatch.

In his speech, Rep. Ellsworth said that one of the biggest jobs facing the new Congress will be labor legislation.

"Lewis came along at the psychological moment and illustrated what is wrong with our labor legislation," he said. "We're going to have to decontrol labor along with the country's businesses." **Need Control**
Concerning regulation of monopolies in business, he added

that "we have so far depended on the Sherman anti-trust law but it is not comprehensive enough. There will have to be additional legislation in that field."

Referring to the "recent split" in the Democratic Party which preceded the Nov. 5 elections, Ellsworth stated:

"There is such a sharp division between the two segments of the Democratic Party that it exceeds the difference between the Democratic and Republican Parties. We are not only representing Republicans, but the conservative segment of the Democratic Party as well."

James Rodman, Jr., who acted as chairman in the absence of Lewis Hoffman, the association's regular chairman, announced that the state meeting of the Young Republican Club will be held in Eugene Feb. 7 and 8, 1947.

Active Club Members Told of Manager Plan

The enabling act for the county manager plan was read and explained to members of the Active Club Thursday by Allen Wheeler, Lane County Commissioner.

Arguments for and against the plan that have been made by Lane County residents were presented by the speaker, who pointed out that the plan is an example of a problem that has been presented so that voters "get the wrong slant on it." A complete study of the act should be made by voters so that they may understand the issue, Wheeler believes.

"The question we must ask ourselves is this: Will the amount of effort we could use to improve our present county government get us more than the same amount of effort applied to setting up a new system of county government?" Wheeler stated.

The county commissioner read several sections from the enabling act, explaining and criticizing each. He mentioned in particular the sections which outline the duties of the county manager, and pointed out that such a man would have to have the highest abilities.

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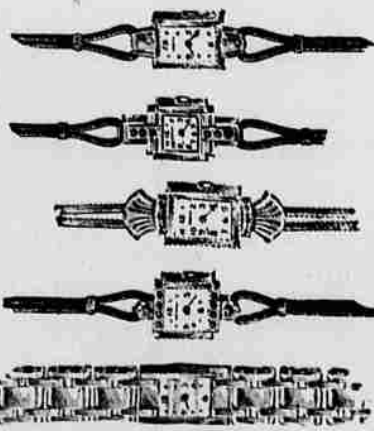
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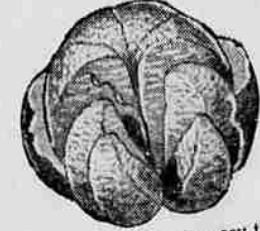
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
