

Standard Appraisal Values For Livestock Agreed Upon

Adoption of a standard table of appraisal valuations for various classes of livestock in 1947 was announced Monday by George Stock, Lane County assessor, and S. C. Payne, appraiser, who returned recently from a meeting of the Willamette Valley Assessor's Assn.

Stock pointed out that the table does not necessarily set fixed rates but will serve as a basic work-sheet so that valuations may be more closely standardized among all the Willamette valley county assessors, as well as official from Josephine, Jackson, and Douglas counties, had indicated that they would use the table.

Most values on the list are in line with those currently used by the assessor said, but the valuation of horses has been reduced "because, except for riding horses, they are a drug on the market." Slight increases were posted for turkeys, rinks, foxes and chinchillas.

Appraisal valuations are approximately 50 per cent of the true market value. The tables set a minimum "true market value" for each type of animal.

Minimum "true" values are established as follows: horses, \$10; cattle—registered, \$124; first grade, \$80, two-year-olds, \$70, yearlings, \$40, common bulls and beef stock, going market rate.

Sheep—good, \$10, culls, \$5; swine—brood sows, \$40, feeder pigs and other hogs, going market rate; poultry—chickens, \$1, ducks, \$1, geese, \$2, turkeys, \$6.

Fur-bearing animals—rabbits, \$1, foxes, \$30, mink, \$30, chinchillas, \$30; goats—milk, \$10, common, \$4, mohair, \$5.

"Luxury" breeds of chinchillas are often appraised at \$1500 or higher. Stock explained, but some "garden variety" breeds may scale

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Death of Section Hand Listed As Accidental

The death of Eddie V. Harrington, 43, railroad section hand, was listed on Lane County sheriff's records as accidental Tuesday and Sheriff C. A. Swarts said that no further investigation would be made.

With state police and a Southern Pacific investigator, Swarts Sunday visited the site 20 miles above Oakridge where the body was discovered last week.

Swarts said that a gash in Harrington's head and a tear in his coat showed grease stains and that the position of the body indicated conclusively that death occurred when a train passed over the man as he was lying on the tracks.

Earlier, an autopsy showed that the only evident cause of death was a cerebral hemorrhage at the point where Harrington's skull was gashed.

NEW YORK, Dec. 31.—(AP)—In the final session of 1946, stocks generally edged upward today although there was nothing resembling a strong rally and scattered market leaders held to the losing rank.

The list churned actively at intervals with occasional slowdowns. Gains of fractions to 3 or more points were well distributed around midday. These were reduced here and there near the close. Transfers for the full proceedings of around 1,700,000 shares were among the largest of the past two weeks.

Better performers included U. S. Steel, General Motors, Firestone Tire (on a promise earnings statement), Southern Railway, Southern Pacific, Chesapeake & Ohio, Goodyear, Caterpillar Tractor, Consolidated Edison, American Can, General Electric, Du Pont, Johns-Manville and Eastman Kodak.

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Chinese Reds Win Ground in Hopeh

PEIPING — (AP) — Chinese Communists gradually tightened their encirclement of Raoting, capital of Hopeh Province, Tuesday and threatened to capture Lu-cheng in their Shantung Province offensive.

Government sources conceded the Communists had captured most National strongpoints within five miles of Raoting, where a small force held out several weeks last fall against a strong assault. Raoting is 90 miles south of Peiping.

Late government reports that Lu-cheng probably could not hold out much longer. The town is 67 miles west of Tsinan, the Shantung capital. The National garrison threw back attacks on its north and south gates, but was faltering under an assault on the east gate.
