Dental Care Program For Vets Increases
Outpatient dental care for Oregon veterans has increased by leaps and bounds during the past few months, Frank Sias, Veterans Administration representative for the Eugene area, reported Monday.
During December, the VA authorized examinations and treatment costing more than \$40,000, as compared to only \$800 last July. These figures represent only care by participating private dentists and not given in VA dental clinics in Portland and Roseburg, Sias said.
Authorizations last month included 198 dental examinations costing \$2744 and treatments for 445 veterans, to cost \$38,612. Actual payments in December, for dental work completed in previous months, amounted to \$7849.50.
In Oregon more than 400 private dentists, representing virtually all counties, are participating in the "home town" dental program. A veteran, after he receives VA authorization, may choose any of these dentists, if the agency's own clinics are not readily available.
Sias explained that free dental care may be obtained only for service-connected disabilities, with presumption favoring the veteran within a year after discharge.
