

Hotels Required To File Forms

Hotels and motor courts cannot qualify for decontrol of their daily rates for transient rooms unless they fill out the required forms, the rent control office announced here Wednesday.

The office added that unless all the required information was reported on the form, the establishment remains under control. The agency reminded the hotel industry that two requirements are necessary for automatic decontrol of transient rooms on or after Feb. 1, 1947. These requirements are: the establishment must have filed the supplementary registration required by OPA in November and December last year, and it must submit to the OPA area office a decontrol form.

The supplementary registration must have been filed, the agency explained, because through that registration the establishment receives its classification as either a transient hotel, residential hotel, motor court or rooming house. Classification as one of the first three of these categories is necessary before decontrol of daily rates is possible. Rooming houses are not included in the decontrol order.

Forms will be available at the rent control office in city hall by Feb. 1.

Wisconsin Senator To Speak in Eugene

U. S. Senator Joseph R. McCarthy of Wisconsin will deliver the main address Feb. 8 when the Eugene chapter of the Young Republicans act as hosts to the annual state convention, to be held in Eugene Feb. 7, 8 and 9.

Robert G. Nielsen, president of the Eugene Junior politicians, said the banquet, at which McCarthy will speak, is scheduled for the Osburn Hotel Saturday night. "After the banquet," Nielsen said, "the convention will adjourn to the Eugene Hotel for a cabaret dance in the Persian Room, to the music of Jimmie Booth and his 10-piece orchestra."

Approximately 250 delegates are expected to be on hand to hear McCarthy, who defeated Robert LaFollette, Jr., for the GOP senatorial nomination last year.

City Taxes Promptly Paid

A report from City Recorder John Fields revealed Wednesday that Eugeneans have paid 87.94 per cent of their total tax levy of \$288,428.59 for the fiscal year 1946-47.
