

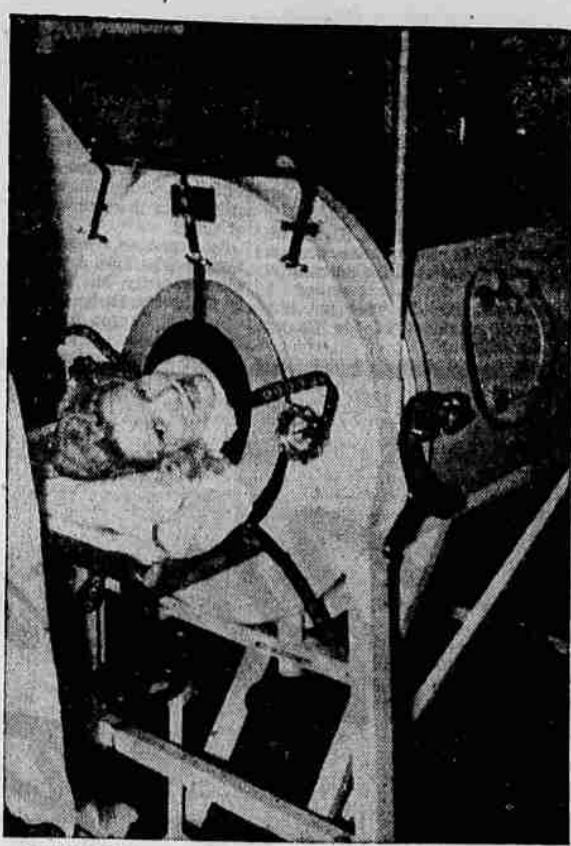
Physicists Get New Equipment
 Acquisition of four pieces of equipment by the physics department of the University of Oregon announced Thursday by Dr. Caswell, head of the department.
 The equipment includes an X-ray machine which is to be used for experimental purposes; a griffier, valued at \$480, for use in the department's shop; and two recording potentiometers for the measurement and recording of voltage and of temperatures up to 3000 degrees Fahrenheit, each valued at \$273.
 Dr. Caswell said shipment is expected in the near future. The items are surplus property of the War Assets Administration.

Iverson Body Found On Newport Beach

The body of Kenneth Reginald Iverson, 19, of Eugene, who was drowned Feb. 23 in Siuslaw Bay, was recovered Wednesday near Newport and brought to Eugene. Previously found was the body of his father, Reginald Iverson, who drowned in the same boating accident, and as yet unrecovered is the body of Kenneth Jacobsen, 20, Eugene, who accompanied the two on the tragic outing.
 Committal services were held Thursday at Rest Haven Memorial Park, with Simon Mortuary in charge.
 Young Iverson was born June 18, 1927 at Fresno, Calif., and came to Eugene in 1937. He enlisted in the Navy in 1945, and was discharged in January, 1946.
 Besides his mother, Mrs. Karen Iverson, he is survived by his grandfather, Garfield Iverson,
