New Plywood Process Told

ABERDEEN, Wash.—(AP)—A. R. Wuest, president of the West Coast Plywood Co., Friday "unveiled" a new, improved-surface plywood known as "Welchboard," for A. R. Welch, vice president of the firm who invented and improved the product.

The new panel production is on a limited scale but will reach volume production in six months. Plywood manufacturers will be licensed to make the new product through the Plywood Research Foundation of Tacoma, nonprofit organization set up by the industry two years ago to eliminate waste and develop new products.

The new process utilizes waste plywood aggregates, in the form of wood flour, bonded with resins to a plywood base. The same hot-plate presses used in making plywood are used to bond the new surface material to plywood panels.

The surface was described as relatively hard and smoother than any present plywood surfaces and has the natural color of the pulverized wood fibers used—light tan in the case of Douglas fir.

It has no grain and no patterns because of the minuteness of the wood fibers bonded together and to the plywood bases.

So far, only clean wastes from plywood manufacture have been used but the probability is seen of obtaining sawdust from sawmills, furniture factories and similar sources and grinding it into "discrete" material for the "Welchboard" raw material.

It has already attracted attention in the industry for interior and exterior construction, refrigerators, counter tops and fine cabinet work.

Ethel M. Hunt, plaintiff, is seeking \$10,000 damages for personal injuries suffered when the car in which she was riding was in collision with one driven by Banta at Washington St. and 17th Ave.

Defendant is Roy A. Banta, administrator of the estate of Earl Mack Banta. He has filed a counter-claim for \$10,000 damages for the latter's death. The plaintiff was in a car driven by Ernest G. West.

The case is being tried before a jury, with Circuit Judge Dal M. King of Myrtle Point on the bench.
