Poultry Flock Disease Seen

With Newcastle disease, a virus ailment which affects poultry of all ages, diagnosed in many states from which Oregon poultrymen obtain baby chicks and breeding stock, State Department of Agriculture veterinarians have warned flock owners to be on the lookout.

The problem has been intensified by increased importations of baby chicks and older stock. In addition, the new and faster methods of transportation, especially airplane delivery, have complicated the problem of keeping Oregon flocks free from this disease.

Newcastle disease is a bronchitis (pneumo-encephalitis) condition which takes a particularly heavy mortality of baby chicks. Although there is no definite proof that the disease is carried through the egg,

it is transmitted by live poultry. Veterinarians warn that strong suspicion of presence of the disease may be warranted when there is a combination of respiratory and nervous symptoms in a flock of sick birds. Other symptoms include tracheal exudate, cloudy air sacs, pale, shrunken spleen and an abrupt and almost complete cessation of laying for several weeks to two months.

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Car Passenger Hurt As Phone Pole Hit
