JUNCTION CITY—A team of 40 boy and girl athletes, from Denmark, will appear Monday, April 21, at Junction City High School at 8 p.m. to give an exhibition demonstrating the strength, flexibility and coordination obtained through the celebrated Danish fundamental gymnastics.

The leader of the team is Erik Flønsted-Jensen, a director of physical education in Copenhagen, who will be assisted by Mrs. Lin-Boerup of the Rødding-Peoples College, oldest among the famed folk schools of Denmark.

The members of this team are all amateurs, young men and women from widely scattered parts of Denmark. The girls' team will feature demonstrations of free calisthenics as well as dancing and classical attitudes on balance beams.

Salem - West Salem Consolidation Viewed

SALEM—(AP)—The Salem City Council made its first move toward consolidation of Salem and West Salem Wednesday night when a committee was appointed to consult with West Salem officials.
