Steamer Burns, Sinks in Bay

SAN FRANCISCO — (AP) — The Swedish steamer Frej rested in 23 feet of water in a shallow corner of San Francisco Bay Wednesday—a victim of fire and water. No casualties were reported.

Fire broke out shortly after the 1976-ton ship left the San Francisco pier Tuesday night. It was controlled around midnight, but the Coast Guard said tons of water poured into the blazing holds caused the Sweden-bound vessel to settle to the bottom.

The Frej, formerly the Stanley A. Griffiths, sailed from Seattle April 21 en route to Gothenburg, Sweden, via Havana.

Special Agents Set For Atom Control

WASHINGTON, May 7.—(AP)—Congress will keep a tighter check on the nation's atomic energy program through special agents operating independently of other government agencies.

This was revealed by Chairman Bourne B. Hickenlooper of the Joint Congressional Atomic Energy committee.

Hickenlooper said the committee will hire about 30 specialists in intelligence, industrial and public relations at a cost of about \$225,000 a year. Their job will be to keep up to date on all phases of the atomic program.

One committee representative is already acting as liaison man with the United States Atomic Energy delegation to the United Nations, the Iowa senator revealed.

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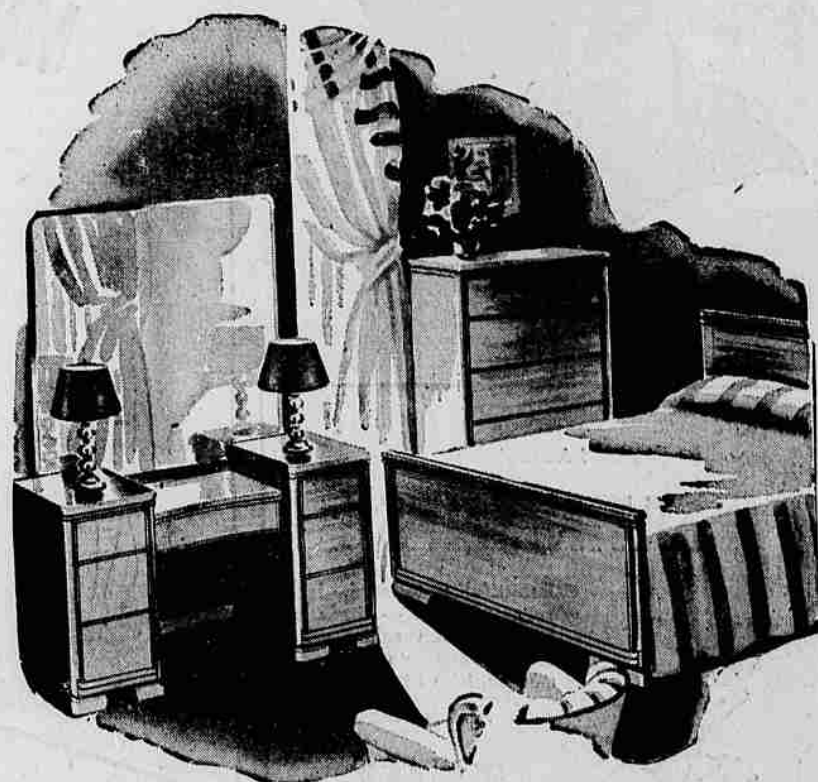
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
