

Jap Volcano Erupts, More Activity Coming

TOKYO—(U.P.)—Mount Aso, the world's largest terrestrial volcano, Wednesday threw out a thousand-foot column of sand, rock and smoke, and Japanese seismologists predicted more violent eruptions to come.

Dispatches from Sendai said a foot column of smoke, landslide, caused by an earthquake preceding the volcanic disturbance, had swallowed 100 acres of farm land and about 400 acres of residential property in Niigata Prefecture.

Mount Aso began erupting Monday when, according to American Army personnel, it belched a 7000-foot column of smoke.

Water District's Organizers Told To Halt Further Action on Plans

Organizers of the proposed Bailey Hill Water Supply District were restrained from any further action to incorporate in that area Tuesday in a circuit court judgment for the plaintiffs.

The suit was filed by a group of Bailey Hill landowners to prevent their farms from being included in the proposed water district on the grounds that such an incorporation would only increase their taxes without adding to their water supply.

set-up," he said, "is that the people sent out by the FBI to investigate are narrow themselves. They ask silly questions like 'Do you read the New Republic,' and other matters that are entirely irrelevant." (Wallace is editor of the New Republic.)

Wallace said he was not afraid of Communism in the United States, and that the Russians cannot fathom our fear of Communism.

He said the only danger of Communist domination lies in areas where there is great misery. Third Party Question

Wallace sidestepped direct questions about a third party. But he said if the Democratic Party "can't be made liberal" then "appropriate action" would have to be decided on.

He said "this third party business" was an inevitable question at each of his stops, but that he had raised it himself only in Portland, Ore., "just to get it over with."

McInnis said that after Wednesday no more meetings will be held in the old Labor Temple at Sixth and Willamette. By Thursday all offices are expected to be moved into new quarters at 728 Willamette St., he said.

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Atom Bombs Might Create 'Death Rain,' Scientists State

WASHINGTON—(U.P.)—Scientists are weighing the possibility of exploding an atomic bomb in the midst of storm clouds to create a literal rain of death.

The advantage of this technique, experts studying the plan told a reporter Wednesday, is that a city far inland could be drenched with radio-activity without the necessity of exploding a bomb under water, as was done in the Bikini experiments.

Until now, coastal cities or those near large rivers or lakes were the most probable targets for such type atomic bombing.

There is, however, a definite possibility that the very power and heat of the bomb might foil the plan.

Some scientists contend that a bomb exploded in a cloud bank might first blast the cloud away and then dissipate its moisture high into the air and away from the target.

But proponents of the idea say it would be necessary only to watch the drift of weather toward a target and select a day when rain clouds several thousand feet thick were floating overhead.

Radar would pick up the target for the bombing plane, and the bomb would be exploded in the thick of the storm. Rain falling from the clouds would be poisoned with the deadly by-product of the bomb's explosion.

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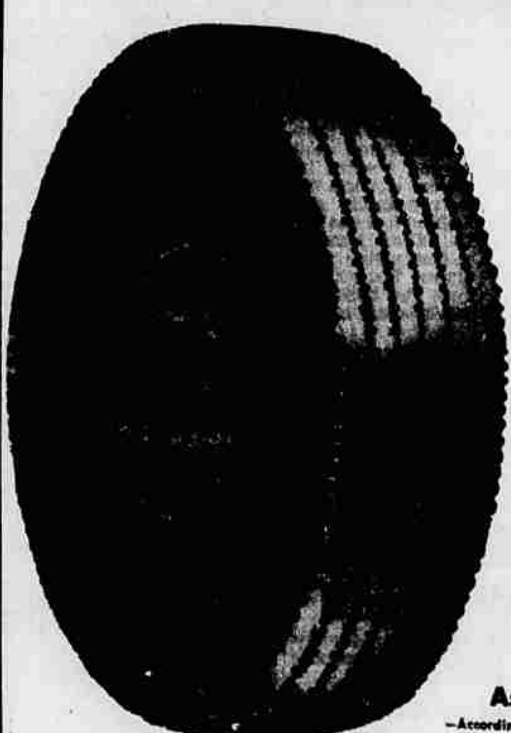
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
