Mutilated Body
Sixth in Cycle

LOS ANGELES—(UP)—The body of Mrs. Rosenda Mondragon, 20, garrotted with a silk cord and her right breast mutilated, was found Tuesday, a black block from the city hall.
She was the sixth victim in the "Black Dahlia" murder cycle that started Jan. 15 with finding of the nude, bisected body of Elizabeth Short, 22.

Mrs. Mondragon's face showed signs of beating, and burns and abrasions on her thighs indicated she was thrown from an automobile.

Newton Josha, a Negro postal clerk, found Mrs. Mondragon's body lying beside the curb at 3:30 p.m. in the downtown area, not far from the city hall.

She was identified through fingerprints in the police department, where records showed she was arrested on a drunk charge March 18, 1946.

For East Intelligence
Service Posts Open

Enlistments and reenlistments in the Regular Army for direct assignment to military intelligence service in the Far East are now authorized for qualified persons who are able to read, write and speak Korean or Russian language fluently.

Applicants must have a record score of 110 or higher on their classification test, or a minimum of 28 on their B-3 or B-4 test. Enlistments must be for three years. Information may be obtained at the recruiting station in the post office.
