### Unarmed Constable Uses Tact, Know-How

### Duties Hard, Varied

Mark Hathaway, Lane County constable, is a versatile man. His everyday dealings include gathering flocks of turkeys, hauling delinquent-payment cars away, herding sheep, and picking up caterpillar tractors.  
Far from the "Simon Legree" that his position as mortgage fore-closer, house evictor, and summons deliverer might make him, Hathaway and his amiable wife Doris, whom he has deputized, are pleasant folks, much quicker with a smile than with a summons.  
"I try to treat people whom I have to collect from for one kind of delinquent payment or another as neighbors," he says, "and it usually works."  
Overcomes Feeling  
"When he delivers the court orders," his wife adds, "people sometimes treat him as the cause of their troubles, but when he comes back, they often load him down with fresh fruit or maybe a chicken. It's fairness and understanding that do it."  
As constable, Hathaway is a county employe delegated to deliver court orders such as mortgage foreclosures on personal property (the sheriff handles real estate foreclosures), orders for payment of mechanic's liens (a money

### Pageant Ticket Sale Arranged

Pageant headquarters open their doors at 9 a.m. Monday for the first over-the-counter sales of tickets to this year's Pageant and rodeo. Headquarters are at 169 E. Broadway.

Reserved seats to the rodeo, which will be held at the Civic Stadium July 24 through 26, will cost \$2.50 including the federal tax, according to Marv Krenk, in charge of arrangements.

General admission tickets to the rodeo, good for any of the three days, are \$1.50 for adults and 80 cents for children.

### Give Time

Krenk said a 2 o'clock starting time had been set for the rodeo events so that patrons would be out in plenty of time to get their dinners and attend the Pageant show in the evening. Extra events, such as Sheriff's Posse formation riding, will take place before 2 p.m. each day.

W. F. G. Thacher, who has written the script for every Pageant, said Saturday that "this one was the most work of any I've ever written. There are more vignettes, and consequently there was more research to be done."

### City Water Plan Includes Filter

Directors of Eugene Water Board will be asked to authorize calling of bids for excavation for footings at the proposed Hayden Bridge filter plant, when they convene in regular session at city hall Monday night.

Although the proposed plant will not be completed until 1949, and plans are not yet fully drawn, this will be the first bid call for construction.

Superintendent Ray Beals said directors will discuss the manner in which Springfield residents will get water from the new filter plant. He said there is "a possibility that the city of Springfield will buy the water from Eugene Power Co., which now provides water from the Willamette River for Springfield residents."

The directors also will discuss an additional water reservoir site in Eugene. The city now has four reservoirs.
