# California Democrats Oppose Third Party in Wallace Rally

FRESNO, Cal.—(AP)—Delegates to a "Draft Wallace" meeting here Saturday night shouted down a move to put California Democrats on record as flatly opposing the idea of a third party.

Former Attorney General Robert W. Kenney told newsmen later that a third party movement to try to place Henry A. Wallace in the White House in 1948 would only come if the Democratic national convention "cynically turns down the will of the people" by choosing President Truman as the party's candidate in the general election.

**Unanimous Vote**  
But the 400-odd Wallace Democrats who came to the meeting from all over the state loudly and unanimously voted for a procedure

al move to silence a United Steel Workers of America, CIO, representative opposing both a third party and Kenney himself.

John Despol, representing the steel workers, said a third party would "only result in a split of the liberal Democratic vote. It would aid the Communists in Europe to defeat the Socialists, and it would aid the National Association of Manufacturers" in this country.

He said he wouldn't "trust anyone as our leader who stabbed Wallace in the back in 1944" and fought to retain state rights to tidelands.

But the conclave delegates, sweltering in a packed hotel ballroom as official temperatures reached 103, said they were "unquestionably and unequivocally

for Wallace" as a Democrat or third party leader.

**Elected Chairman**  
And they gave Kenney a unanimous vote of confidence by electing him chairman of their important steering committee. Other members, expected to total not more than 15, were to be chosen later.

Two former Congressmen—Ellis Patterson and Ned Healey, both of Los Angeles—attended the meeting and urged an all-out campaign for Wallace. In less than 15 minutes, \$1500 in amounts ranging from \$5 to \$250 was contributed to the campaign.

Kenney told the delegates that it is up to the western Democrats to "make a blueprint" for the country to follow.
