cost factor used in every case is established by the state tax commission, classified as to the type of building, and ordinarily runs from \$2.50 to \$6.50 per square foot. However, present construction costs range from \$6.50 to \$10.50 per square foot.

"We hope to complete the re-evaluating by the end of 1947, and this no doubt will show a normal increase in the assessed value merely for the reason of the natural growth in population and industrial expansion since 1936, the date of the last complete appraisal," Stock added.

"Sound Value"
Stock declared that "most people blame the assessor for high taxes, whereas his job is only to assess and appraise all property at its true sound value according to law."

Schools were mentioned by Stock as presenting the main problem. He showed statistics proving that in the period from 1945-46 to 1946-47, the demands from the schools increased 124 per cent. He believes much of the increase was justified, due to increased demands for more building and facilities, more teachers, and increased cost of salaries and supplies. If some economizing is not done on the part of the school, the total Eugene levy may reach or exceed 100 mills in the near future, Stock declared.

The proposed sales tax as enacted by the last session of the legislature, and which will be voted on Oct. 7, provides that one sixth of the revenue shall go each to the counties, schools and cities, to offset property taxes. Based on a conservative estimate of 22 mil-

Woman Threatens Senator Bricker

COLUMBUS, O. (U.P.)—Associates of Sen. John W. Bricker, who escaped assassination in Washington two weeks ago, revealed Friday that three phone calls were received at Bricker's Columbus home last night in which the caller threatened "to get him."

Authorities said they believed the caller was a demented person. The caller was a woman, Mrs. R. M. Day, mother of Mrs. Bricker, said the woman called three times about the dinner hour. She first asked for the Senator, then for his wife, Bricker, who was preparing to attend a state Republican rally, did not go to the phone. Mrs. Bricker is in Canada. "You tell that son-in-law of yours we're going to get him and

this isn't maybe," Mrs. Day quoted the caller.

At the request of the Senator, suburban Upper Arlington police patrolled the residence where Mrs. Day was alone after her son-in-law left for the rally. A police escort was given Bricker at the rally, although he did not request it.
