**Housing Office In Bay Center**

Official business of the Public Housing Administration (formerly FPMA) in the west will be conducted entirely out of the San Francisco office beginning Friday, Aug. 15, Jesse Epstein, director of the new, combined region, announced Wednesday.

Epstein said that consolidation of the former Seattle and San Francisco regional offices into one coast-wide region is progressing rapidly and should be completed by Aug. 22. After Aug. 15, however, all communications should be mailed to the San Francisco office, 780 Market St.

The new combined region includes Washington, Oregon, Idaho, Montana, Wyoming, California, Nevada, Utah, Arizona and the territories of Alaska and Hawaii. All cities and communities in these states and territories in which federally-owned or aided public housing projects are located therefore will now deal directly with the San Francisco PHA office.

The consolidation of the two regions resulted from the reduced budget established by Congress in the closing days of the last session. At the same time, under a reorganization of the housing agencies, the FPMA became the Public Housing Administration.

**Meyer Seen In New York**

NEW YORK — (AP) — Johnny Meyer, Howard Hughes' freespending press agent who is booked for a return engagement before a Senate sub-committee investigating his boss' wartime airplane contracts, was reported back in New York Wednesday, haunting the city's plushiest night clubs where he won his spurs as a party-giver during the war.

Where Meyer was staying was a secret U. S. marshals and pretty Patricia Miles would like to know. But he said he planned to remain here for a while with friends.

**Warrant and Subpoena**  
 The portly press agent, who provided the comedy in last week's Senate investigation of his expense account and entertainment of high Army officers, was wanted by the marshals who had a subpoena to service on him.

Miss Miles, a nightclub cigaret girl, had a warrant out for his arrest, charging that he was the father of her six months old son.

Meyer disappeared Friday shortly after the Senate sub-committee decided it wanted him to reappear before it again. His whereabouts were unknown until Monday night when he visited the El Morocco. He said he had been staying in Richmond, Va., not far from Washington, alone.

**Avoids Queries**  
 He joined a party composed of Steward Barthelme, and his sister, Mary, children of silent screen star Richard Barthelme. Barthelme said Meyer appeared as gay as ever, but declined to discuss his appearance before the Senate sub-committee.

Neither did he offer to pick up any checks, Barthelme said.

**Three GI's Beaten By German Gang**

BERLIN — (AP) — U. S. Military police disclosed Wednesday that three American soldier guards at Spandau prison, where the Nuernberg war criminals are held, were attacked while off duty Tuesday night by a gang of 30 to 50 Germans.

Pfc Philip Bell of Cambridge, Md., was beaten unconscious and

thrown into a lake. He was rescued and taken to a hospital. Two of the attacked soldiers fled to safety.

Constabulary headquarters identified one of the two soldiers with Bell as Leo D. Wong of Hillsboro, Wis.

The Army Criminal Investigation Division was called to investigate. The attackers were identified. The soldiers were attacked in a park not far from the prison at 11:30 p. m. The reason for the attack had not been established.
