

# Expansion of 4-H Club Program Planned by Oregon State Staff

A five-point program for expanding and improving 4-H work in Oregon has been announced by F. L. Ballard, associate director of the Oregon State College extension service.

The program is designed to increase enrollment slightly above last year's total of 22,000, increase the percentage of club members completing their projects, give more training to voluntary local leaders, and guide the selection and organization of 4-H Club projects in the counties in line with the general over-all rural affairs program being worked out by the farm families of each county in rural program-making conferences.

The first step in the program, Ballard explained, is the building of a new staff of leaders, a development necessitated by retirement of H. C. Seymour and Miss Helen Cowgill, veteran members of the extension club department staff.

L. J. Allen has replaced Seymour as state club leader. Mrs. Winnifred Gillen, former Klamath County home demonstration agent, has replaced Miss Cowgill, and Cal Monroe was added to the staff as assistant state leader some months ago. Two other experienced leaders will be added to the club staff within the next six months, Ballard said.

Commenting that only slightly more than 77 per cent of the state's 4-H members completed their projects last year, the associate director said it is the opinion of many that completion should reach 85 per cent of the regular enrollment. Work with volunteer local leaders will be aimed at raising the percentage of completions, he stated.

The 35 projects now available to Oregon 4-H members are being carefully studied with a view to adding some new ones and eliminating others. One series of new clubs which likely will be offered lies in the field of wildlife. Attention also is being given to promotion of projects that are in line with recommendations of county program planning conferences.

# Shortage of Dollars Hampers Canadians

LONDON—(AP)—Canada's shortage of United States dollars makes it appear "inevitable" that the dominion will have to reduce American imports, the Financial Times said in an editorial this week.

If such a situation arises and Canada finds herself "drawn, at least in a limited sense, into the sterling group of countries, Britain must make a maximum endeavor to see that the resulting shortages of manufactured goods in Canada are of the shortest possible duration," the Financial Times declared.

Due to her position midway between the United States and the sterling area, "Canada had a greater interest than almost any other country" in re-establishing multi-lateral trade but the results have been disappointing due to the slow recovery of European countries.

Canada received 50 per cent of her export surplus to Britain in dollars, but once the United Kingdom American credits were exhausted the dominion faced "a serious problem."

"Unless this country is prepared to dip heavily into the gold reserve or is furnished with a new supply of United States dollars under the Marshall plan which could be utilized to finance a continuing adverse trade balance with the dominion, Canada must be prepared to undertake a thorough reorientation of her foreign trade and financial policy."

# Cranberry Crop Increase Of 11 Per Cent Seen

PORTLAND — (AP) — Oregon's 1947 cranberry crop of 18,000 barrels will be an 11 per cent increase over last year and double the 10-year average, the Department of Agriculture reported this week.

A spokesman said the Oregon crop is early and that picking will begin early in September.
