Street Money Meeting Held

SPRINGFIELD—City Attorney William S. Fort returned here Thursday after attending a conference with the State Highway Commission in Salem Wednesday. Fort said the highway commission discussed disposition of the \$250,000 fund set up by the 1947 Legislature to be used in cities that have experienced damage to streets by heavy industrial traffic. Fort was one of three men selected by the League of Oregon Cities to consult with the highway commission on this problem. The others were Fred Inkster of Oswego and Hollis Smith, mayor of Dallas.

County Surveyor Lashes Failure to Object to Proposed Jasper Road Grade Crossing

Concern of the State Highway Department and penny-pinching by Southern Pacific Railroad were blamed Thursday by P. M. Morse, Lane County surveyor, for lack of action to prevent a grade crossing near Jasper. Morse explained that the grade crossing would be on the county road near Jasper when the road crosses the main S. P. line are required to make way for the Meridian damsite and its future back-water.

The Lane County court had previously asked a delay in action, carried on by the U. S. Army engineers before the State Public Utilities Commission, so that they could have more time to study the road. The court will attend a hearing before the utilities commission and the State Highway Commission in Portland Aug. 25. Morse lashed out at the S. P. be-

cause they "had no objection to the crossing because they didn't want to spend money." He emphasized that at the last county court, 734 cars, 123 of them heavy trucks, and 25 trains used the location during a 24-hour period.

Denies Claim
"The highway department claims to have no jurisdiction in the matter, saying the road belongs to the county," related Morse, "but the road is a federal aid project and therefore directly controlled by the State Highway Department." Morse was objecting to the highway department's refusal to aid the county in preventing the construction of the grade crossing.

The War Department Engineers, however, to back up the county's case before the P. U. C. took a later count of cars at the crossing which agreed with the county's number. Their first count was very low.

Morse said he never expected to see both the highway department and the railroad "go on record as having no objection to a grade crossing."

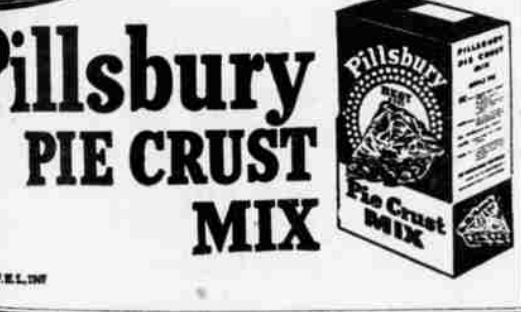
