WHY DO WE NOT USE INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC? Many are perplexed to find that the churches of Christ do not use mechanical instruments in worship, and often call for an explanation. (The Christian Churches, sometimes known as Churches of Christ, do use instrumental music.) But we believe it to be sinful to use it, since it is unauthorized in the New Covenant, or the law of Christ. Jesus stated that "God is a Spirit, and they that worship Him must worship Him in Spirit and in Truth." (Jn. 4:24) "Thy word is truth." (Jn. 17:17) To worship God in TRUTH then is to do so according to His Word—the Bible. By studying the Bible we learn that God commands us to serve Him NOW according to the teachings of Jesus Christ—not Moses. Christ's will comprise the realm of "truth" by which the worshiper is circumscribed. The worship is also to be spiritual. Instruments made by man have neither spirit nor are spiritual. Paul said in Athens, "Neither is (God) worshipped with men's hands," thus we see that mechanical instruments are excluded. Rather the spiritual melody of the human heart is that intended. (Eph. 5:19; Col. 3:16). Since the law of Christ does not teach instrumental music to be used, it is a sin to use it, for to add to His Word is sin. (See Rev. 22:18; Deut. 4:2; 12:32; 1 Cor. 4:6)
