

Neighbors Seeking Donations for Poorly-Housed Families

Plans for donations of furniture, clothing and other necessities for the north end of the city were voiced today by Mrs. Mary Zunk, 477 15th Ave. E.

She said 15 to 18 families are living in tents and shanties in the area because they are unable to find housing. Lack of transportation has prompted inspection by county authorities.

She said the belief that the poverty of the families is due to the fact that some of the families are "lazy" is a "big mistake," Mrs. Zunk quoted Bible verses and said that the families are "not lazy" but they need floor covering, tarpaper, wash tubs, stove pipe, and some sweaters and shoes for their kids.

She also asked that a barber visit the settlement to cut the children's hair, and suggested that ornaments and trimming for a Christmas tree be donated.

Those donating materials may leave them with Mrs. Zunk any evening, or may take the goods to the camp. To reach the district, drive north over the bridge and take the first road to the right for a few hundred yards.

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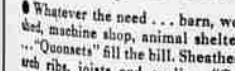
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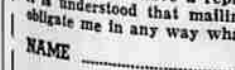
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Wheat, Corn Prizes Given at Show

CHICAGO—(U.P.)—A Canadian wheat farmer and an Indiana corn grower Monday shared a throne as "grain kings of the world" after their grains won top prizes at the International Hay and Grain show.

S. J. Allsop, Red Deer, Alberta, Canada, won the wheat title with a "reward" variety of hard red spring wheat in Sunday's final judging at the show, held in conjunction with the International Livestock Exposition.

Walter J. Harpel of Crawfordsville, Ind., won the international corn championship with a 10-car sample of yellow dent corn.

Allsop won his title after narrowly beating last year's winner, Mrs. Amy Kelsey, British Columbia, who was second in this year's competition.

Cubsters Stop In Arizona

PHOENIX, Ariz., (U.P.)—Cub Pilots George Truman and Clifford Evans Monday prepared to take off in their tiny planes for Amarillo, Tex., the next leg of their jaunt back to Teterboro, N. J., after a leisurely globe-circling flight.

When the flivver pilots set their Piper Cubs down here after a 350-mile, four-hour trip from Los Angeles, they were greeted by an official Arizona delegation headed by Secretary of State Dan Garvey and Mayor Ray Bussey of Phoenix.

Fog delayed their takeoff from Los Angeles, where they tested a week after a record-breaking flight into the U. S. from Canada.

The unique junket will end at Teterboro, where they took off last Aug. 9 to circle the globe to prove that small private planes can make it around the world.

After Amarillo, the next scheduled stop was Oklahoma City. They said they might also stop at Kansas City and Chicago, but were not sure.

Mt. State Power Co. has been interested in such a project because, if it should develop, they plan to install a new industrial power line next to the road.

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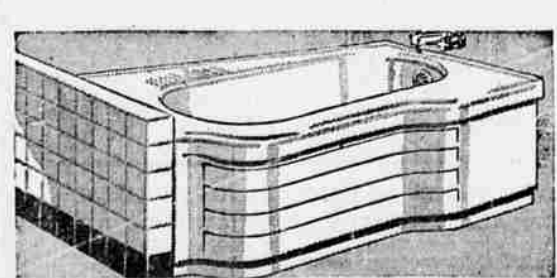
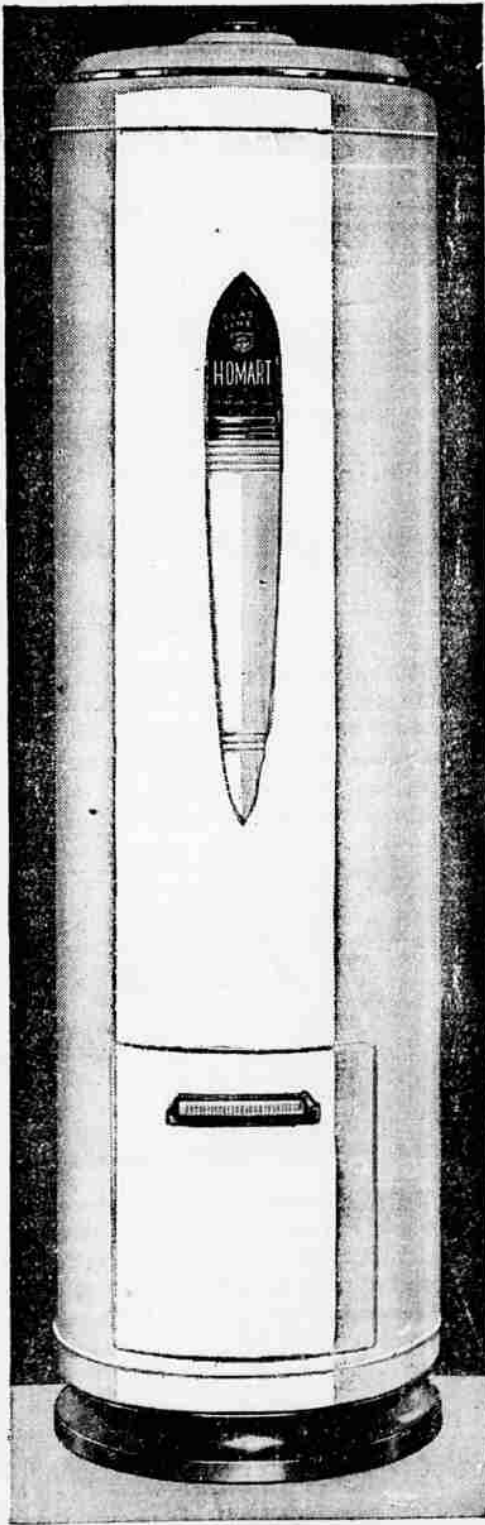
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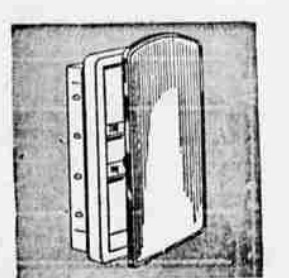
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
