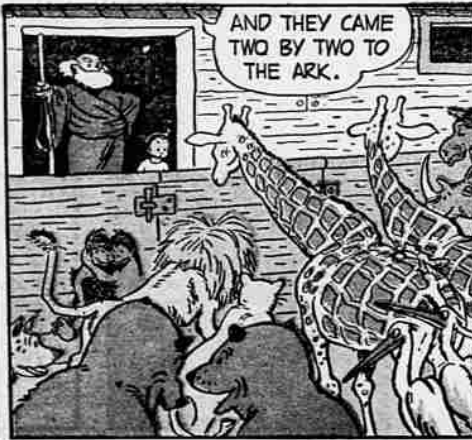


NOAH BUILT THE ARK.

AND HE CALLED ALL THE DIFFERENT ANIMALS OF THE EARTH.



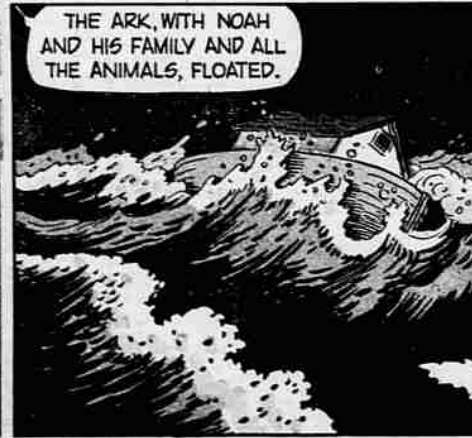
AND THEY CAME TWO BY TWO TO THE ARK.

THE ARK, WITH NOAH AND HIS FAMILY AND ALL THE ANIMALS, FLOATED.



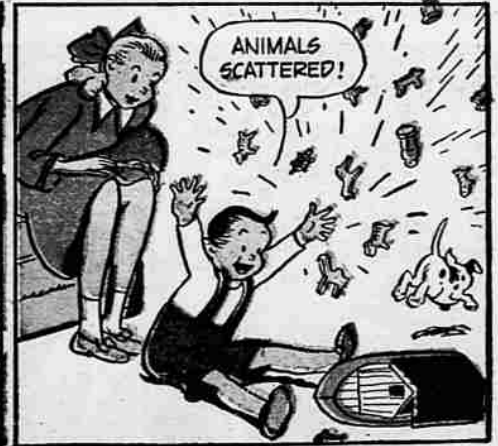
FINALLY, HE SENT OUT A DOVE—WHICH RETURNED CARRYING AN OLIVE LEAF.
