Electrical Men Say Aid Offered

Full cooperation "during any recognized emergency" was promised Wednesday by members of Local 659 of the Electrical Workers Union, according to O. M. McDonald, assistant business representative of the local.

McDonald said in a statement that the union pledged its services without charge during such emergencies, and would work through licensed electrical shops or "other proper channels."

He said union members had volunteered in answer to an appeal Tuesday for men to help install wiring at flood evacuation camps.

Members of the local have been "on vacation" since Jan. 1. They are seeking a wage scale of \$2 an hour and "other working conditions," McDonald said.

Negotiations with contractors have "fallen down," McDonald added.

Lost Child Found Dead

OLYMPIA, — (U.P.) — The body of Bobby Torget, 3½, missing since Monday, was found washed up on the beach six miles north of his home near here on Puget Sound.

A neighbor of the Torget's, Ralph Zink, found the body. The sheriff's office said the tide and currents carried the body north around Hunter's Point and deposited it on Steamboat Island. More than 250 men, two seaplanes and six to eight boats and tugs were employed in the search.

The youngster was last seen throwing stones into Mud Bay inlet near his home.

Brooklyn Port Lighted by Flames

NEW YORK — (AP) — A 1000-foot pier and its cargo were destroyed, a freighter damaged and two barges burned in a \$1,500,000 fire which raged on the Brooklyn waterfront early Wednesday.

Lower Manhattan and a large section of the harbor were lit up at the height of the blaze.

Three hundred firemen with five fireboats and 35 pieces of land apparatus fought the flames. Four firemen fell overboard from a fireboat and were taken to a hospital for treatment.

working to pump out as many basements in this and other areas as possible, but the number of calls far exceeded the available pumping equipment and manpower.

The city's storm sewers were still heavily loaded at noon, Mullins said, mainly due to back-pressure from the Willamette River which slowed the rate of runoff. Surface water will be slow draining until the river level goes down.

Mullins reported little difficulty with back-pressure in the sewers forcing manhole covers loose, but said this pressure had resulted in water backing into many basements which were otherwise free from the flood.

West of Eugene the Amazon flowed over the extension of Eleventh Ave. Tuesday in volume which residents said was greater than during any other recent flood.

Statistical estimates of the total acreage which the stream inundated between the city and Clear Lake were not obtainable, but persons living in the area reported that they believed as much property was under water Tuesday afternoon as during any flood period in the last 25 years.

The suburban area at the west of Eugene was still a picture of houses and other buildings standing in "fields" of water Wednesday morning although the water level was falling.

The second peak of the Amazon flood, resulting from the heavy rains during the night was expected to reach the Clear Lake area Wednesday afternoon.

east of Portland had one-way traffic due to slides.

The Evergreen highway in Washington, paralleling the Columbia River, was closed as water-logged ground gave way under the highway edge east of Bingen. Union Pacific main line tracks east of Portland were closed by a slide and trains were re-routed to the Washington side of the river. The tracks were later opened and normal traffic resumed.
