

Council Accepts Bids, Hears Petitions in Busy Session

Supplementary actions taken by the city council at Monday's meeting included acceptance of a 19.4-cent bid from the Petro-Lane Oil Co. for provision of the city's 1948 gasoline requirements of approximately 30,000 gallons.

The bid, lowest of eight entered, includes the 5-cent state tax which is refunded to city after the gasoline is used, but excludes federal tax inasmuch as the city is automatically exempt from such payments.

More Bids
The 19.4-cent bid represents

the discount from the present and Seventh Ave. E. the proposed tank price which will be proportionately accorded by the company at the time of the city's gasoline purchases.

Millrace Issue
This council action followed a recommendation from the judiciary committee whose report contained an explanation that the property was acquired by the city in the purchase of the millrace, and that its use in connection with the highway project would be in accordance with an agreement with the state for 50-50 sharing on right-of-way expenses for the relocation of the Pacific highway.

A report from the Board of Appeals recommending granting of Walter L. Burkhardt's petition for permission to add two bathrooms to property at 892 Fifth Ave. W. was adopted. Upon like recommendation the council denied an appeal from Leslie A. Wilson for authority to erect a laundry building at 2650 University St.

Auditor Report
The council heard a report from the city's auditor, Percy W. Brown, stating that the financial records of the city were audited through Sept. 30, 1947, and found to be in proper balance.

A petition from Mrs. Amelia Bennett requesting reclassification of property at 1711 Columbia to permit construction of a duplex was referred to the Planning Commission.

Permission
Permission was granted Chief of

Police Keith Jones to live one block outside the city limits. The councilmen discussed the city's housing shortage and ruled that the specific authority would be granted in view of the prevailing condition.

Five rooming house licenses were approved upon the recommendations of the police, fire and health departments, and Ernie Piluso, 157 East was granted a restaurant liquor license upon approval of the application by the chief of police.

Stop Signs
Authority was granted by the council for installation of stop signs on Twelfth Ave. E. at its intersection with Hilyard following a report by the police department that the number of accidents at that location has been disproportionate to the flow of traffic.

Two proposed ordinances were referred to the public works committee by action of the council. One calls for amendments to the city plumbing code, and the other is intended to regulate sewer construction, repairs, and reconstruction by requiring application for permits for such work.

Another ordinance, for the levying of assessments for the construction of sidewalk on the east side of Filmore St., between West Broadway and Eleventh Ave., was given first reading at the meeting.
