Eastern Clam Eating Champ Grooms for Title Match

MARTHA'S VINEYARD—(U.S.)—East Coast Clam Eating Champion Joseph H. Silva left Thursday for Seattle, where he hopes to gobble his way to the world title in the East-West Clam Bowl contest.

Trainer Joseph Correia said he

had worked the husky father of seven children to "the most superb eating trim of his career" and was confident Silva would defeat Seattle's Richard Watson, Pacific Coast titlist, by "maybe a bucket or two."

The Martha's Vineyard self-styled "Golden Boy" who garnered the eastern crown in a clam of Edgartown, Mass., will leave aboard a Northeast Airlines plane at Logan Airport in Boston.

Silva, after a brief stopover at New York City, will continue by plane and is expected to arrive at Seattle Friday morning—the day of the clam bowl tilt. He is to be met by a welcoming committee and a brass band.

Silva said he planned a final "sparring session" at Boston's swank Hotel Somerset before boarding his plane. He said he contemplated "a few test eats against a stop watch, but nothing real grueling because I don't want to get trained down too fine."

Correia said Silva probably would consume 40 or 50 clams in his last tune up. He said the champion was primarily concerned with speed.

"He's got the capacity," Correia explained. "He's got to work on his husking technique—delivering the clam from the shell and reaching for the next one. Those are the little fine points that may decide the title."

Auburn Names Coach

AUBURN, Ala., Jan. 22.—(AP)—Auburn's weeks-long search for a head football coach ended with the naming of Earl M. Brown, Canisius College mentor and former Notre Dame star, to the post.

Appointment of the 32-year-old coach was announced Wednesday night by Acting President Ralph Draughon of Alabama salary terms were not disclosed.

In the past ten years American per capita annual use of textiles has risen from about 33 pounds to about 45 pounds.

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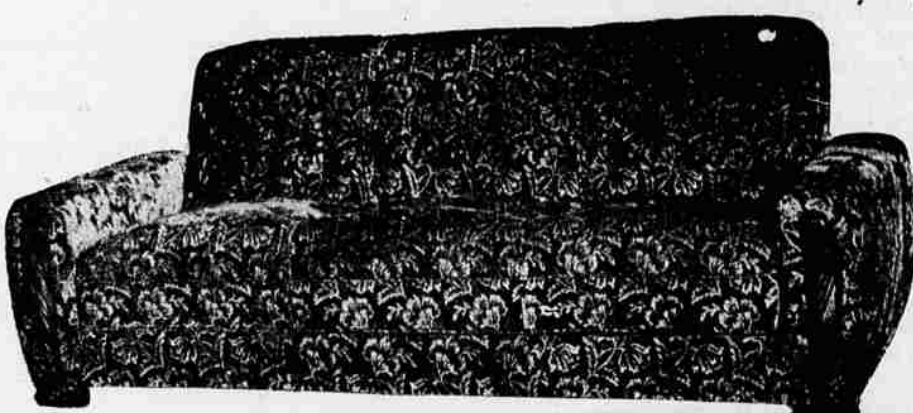
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
