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Unions On Record For Rent Control

WASHINGTON—(AP)—The CIO Saturday proposed a 28-month extension of rent controls and the wiping out of all 15 per cent "voluntary" increases made under the present law.

Donald Montgomery, chief of the Washington office of the CIO Auto Workers, presented the program in a statement prepared for a Senate banking subcommittee.

The present federal rent control act expires Feb. 29. The subcommittee, headed by Senator Cain (R-Wash.), will hold one more week of hearings on the question what to do next.

Friday the AFL presented its program for extending rent controls.
