Drugs for Europe Train Scheduled

NEWARK, N. J.—(AP)—A coast-to-coast "Drug Train" to collect medical supplies for Europe was planned Wednesday night by the New Jersey pharmaceutical association.

The group, in mid-winter convention, adopted a resolution proposing the nation's pharmacies become depots for collection of drugs and medicines needed overseas.

Dr. Ernest Little, president-elect of the American Pharmaceutical Assn. and former dean of Rutgers College of Pharmacy, promised support of the national group.

If approved nationally, the plan would work this way:

The general public would contribute by donating 25 cents or more in collection boxes set up in pharmacies. Wholesale drug houses would supply the drugs at cost and turn them over to a national collection group, probably the American Pharmaceutical Assn.

Christmas Cactus Is Biggest So Far
