OUR LORD SAID:

"Nevertheless I tell you the truth: It is expedient for you that I go away; for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I go, I will send him unto you. And he, when he is come, will convict the world in respect of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment; of sin, because they believe not on me; of righteousness, because I go to the Father, and ye behold me no more; of judgment, because the prince of this world hath been judged (John 16:7-11). The Holy Spirit came into the world to 'convict the world.' This is the message brought to us by Christ.

Every true child of God has been convicted of sin. In his turning to God a conviction was necessary. But does it necessarily follow that a direct operation of the Holy Spirit takes place to convict one? Some people think that unless one teaches some direct, incomprehensible, inconceivable, unintelligible, intangible, mystical, better-felt-than-told sort of an operation of the Spirit that he leaves the Spirit out. One does not need in the least these 'fairy notions' about the work of the Spirit. Let us prove our contention.

In Acts 2 the conviction and conversion of 3000 people is described. Study carefully what happened. The Holy Spirit fell in baptismal measure upon the apostles. The noise of His coming went abroad in the city of Jerusalem. The multitude of Jews, who were from every nation under heaven, came together. The multitude heard the apostles speaking in the many languages. Peter explained that what was happening came in fulfillment of Joel 2:28-30. Peter then preached the gospel. When Peter had reached the conclusion of his sermon, men were pricked in their hearts—convicted. How were they convicted? Simply by the message that Peter preached. We have the same message. It operates the same way.
