committee rent controls ought to be continued two more years and made stronger. That group is just opening hearings on whether to keep controls which will end Feb. 29 unless Congress votes to continue them.

In this connection, Sen. Cain (R-W) said the program he outlined to Woods late Monday would work something like this:

1. The rent control law, now due to expire at the end of this month, would be extended, possibly until June 30, 1949.
2. There would be no blanket increase. But tenants and landlords would be authorized to negotiate leases calling for whatever increase they agreed upon. The leases would run for some definite period, which Congress would specify, beyond the expiration of controls.
3. Properties covered by leases would be decontrolled, either on signing or at some later date.
4. Tenants who refused to sign leases would be covered by the general law until it expired.

Cain, whose subcommittee hopes to act on a bill by week's end, indicated that under this plan some rent increases agreed upon would be for less than the 15 per cent maximum authorized under the present law.

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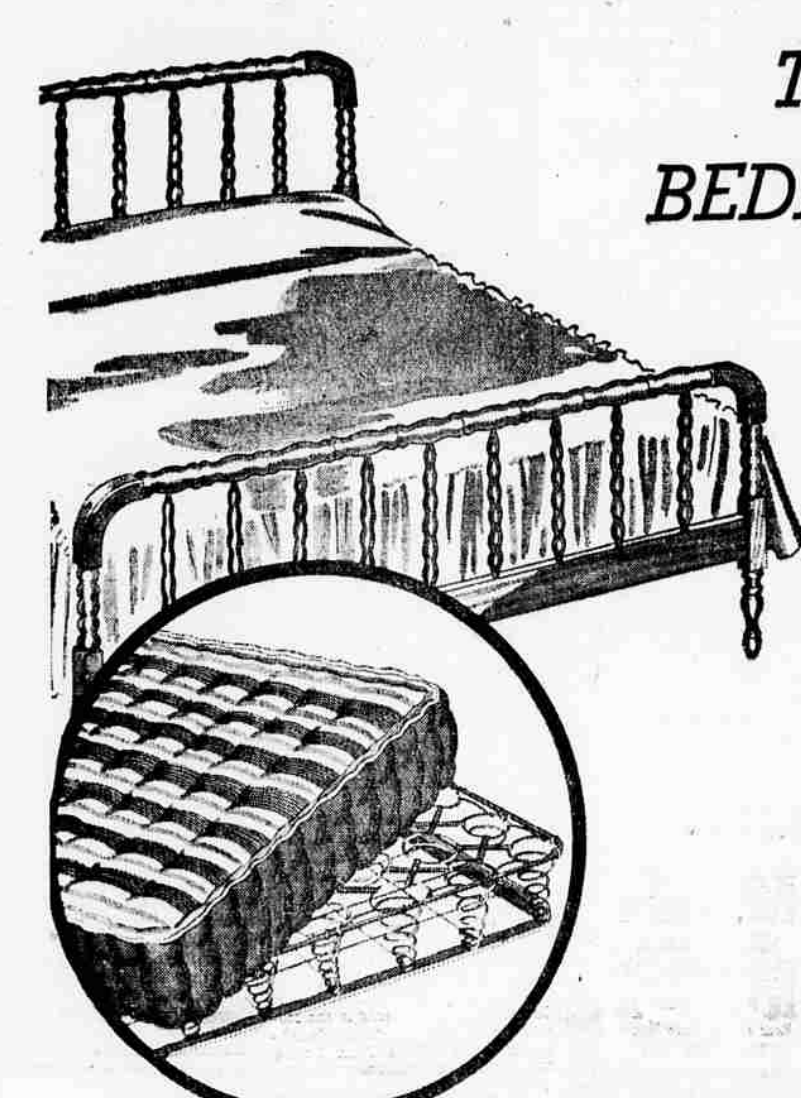
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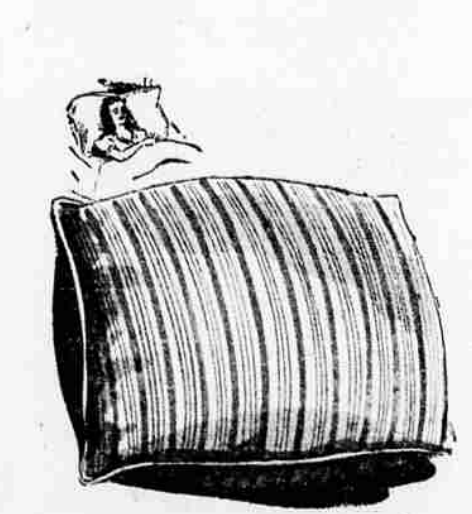
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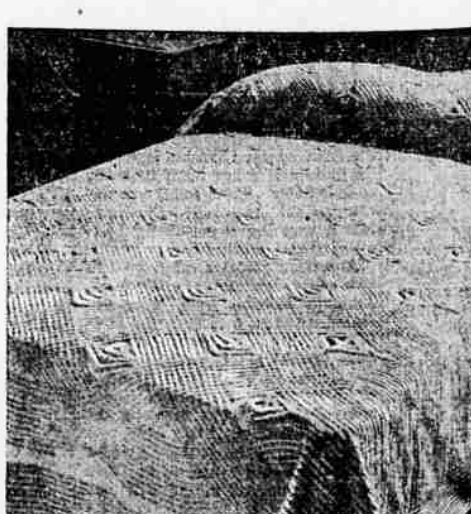
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
