

Attorney Tells Kiwanis Club Of Views on T-H Labor Act

Some of the legal aspects of the Taft-Hartley law were discussed before the Kiwanis Club Monday noon by William Riddlesbarger, Eugene attorney and member of the Kiwanis Club.

Prefacing his remarks with the statement that "basically, I favor management," the speaker pointed out that he is not opposed to unions, and "has nothing

against them or their members."

Sees Power

"The unions have done much for the workers, but they have grown powerful," Riddlesbarger complained. Now the union management is guilty of excesses, and employers have been found guilty of them in the past, he pointed out.

The Taft-Hartley law is intended to deal with the excesses, and to provide management and union management with rules by which to conduct their disputes, Riddlesbarger declared.

Unions have grown so powerful that they no longer need to show their power to gain their ends, the speaker believes. He declared that many employers have been intimidated into decisions to avoid labor trouble. He noted that "union men travel in groups and are usually big fellows."

'Preserves Rights'

Although the Taft-Hartley law may seem a bit harsh, the basic rights of labor are preserved, Riddlesbarger asserted. The law defines certain acts as unfair labor practice on the part of the unions, and prohibits closed shop and featherbedding. It states that

SALEM —(P)—Unemployment compensation benefits in Oregon during May totaled \$520,874, a decline of 28 per cent from April. The total was 17 per cent less than in May, 1947.

Payments to unemployed veterans under the GI bill of rights were \$402,174. This was slightly more than a year ago, but 34 per cent under April.

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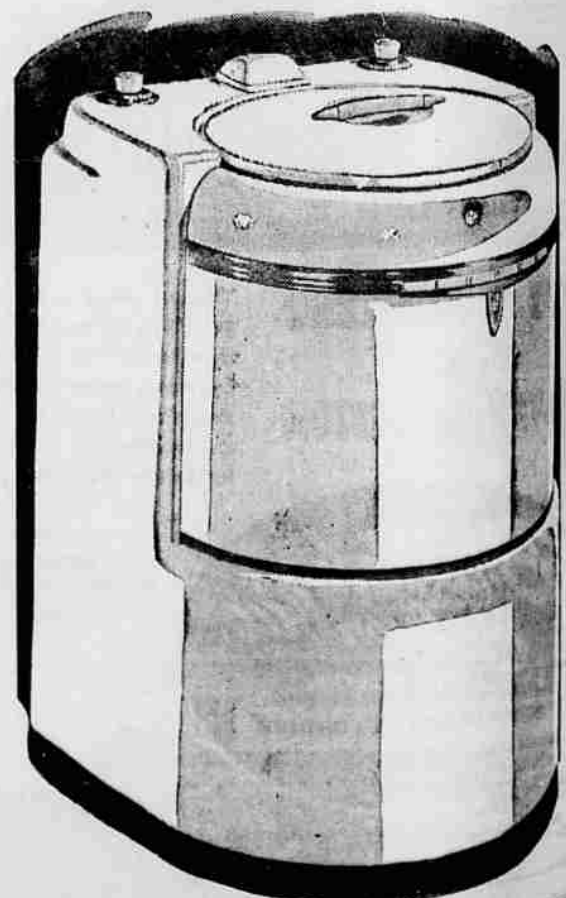
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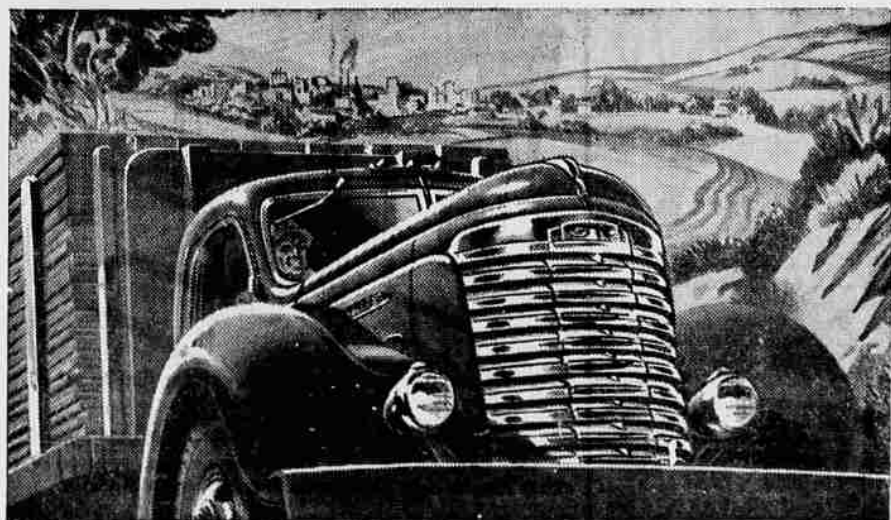
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
