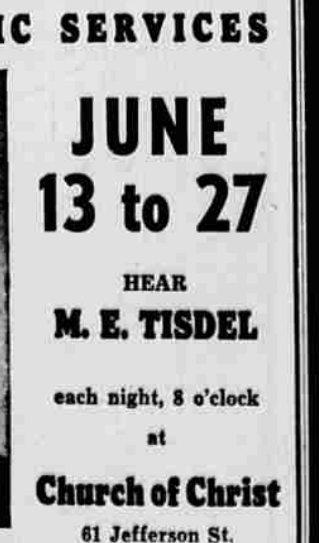

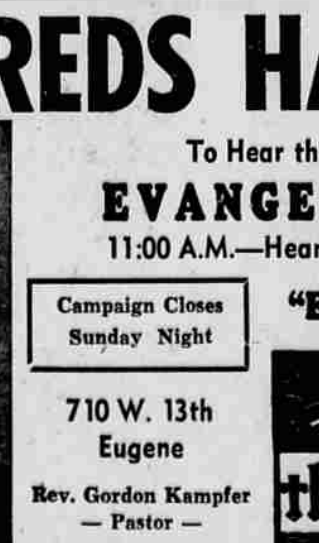

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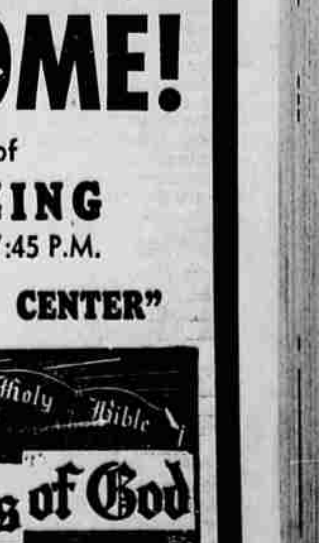

You have just read the account of a ruler who was visibly moved by the powerful preaching of Paul. No doubt Paul clearly showed Felix his sinful condition and revealed to his fate in the Day of Judgment if he persisted in his present course of life. Felix was greatly disturbed by Paul's message and sent him away with the excuse that the time was not convenient to accept the faith that Paul was preaching. You may read the remainder of the chapter and you will find that the "convenient season" never came to Felix. Why? Simply because Satan never allows the convenient time to arrive. As long as a man is waiting until it becomes convenient to become a Christian, Satan knows that he still has hope in keeping one more soul in the bonds of sin. Christianity demands sacrifice on the part of him who would live a life pleasing to God. One of the major faults of the world today is that men are willing to serve God only when it is convenient. God will not have that kind of service. You must be willing to pay the cost that Christianity demands. When the angel of Death summons you to appear before the throne of judgment, how tragic it will be if you are still waiting for that convenient season which never came.
