Summer Class Opens Monday

A six-weeks summer school session will be opened in Eugene public schools Monday morning, June 14.

The school will be open to all grades, from elementary through senior high school. All elementary work will be carried on from 8:30 to 12 noon five days a week at Condon School, 1550 Moss St. At Eugene High

All junior and senior high school work will be carried on at Eugene

High School, 250 Seventeenth Ave. W., from 8 to 12 noon five days a week.

Summer school classes will enable children in the elementary and junior high grades to brush up on courses in which they lagged during the winter term.

Senior high students will be able to earn credits during the summer, as well as to complete some required courses if they want to devote more time to elective courses during the coming winter.

Violin Lessons
 Elementary students wishing to take beginning violin lessons may do so under the tutelage of Mrs. Winifred Young, the regular grade school instrumental teacher.

The school district provides the housing for summer school sessions, but the program itself must be self-supporting. For that reason senior high school students will be required to pay \$20 for the six-weeks term. Elementary and junior high students will pay \$15.
