

With Sprays Coming

First cover spray for con-
trolling moths on apple
trees should be applied
June 15, so as to give pro-
tection against the larvae from
now being laid. This is
the advice of B. G. Thompson, en-
tomologist at the Oregon State
College Experiment Station.

There are three recommended
spray mixtures — lead arsenate,
calcium arsenate, or DDT. How-
ever, Thompson warns that use of
DDT, although outstandingly effec-
tive, results in several complica-
tions. The orchard owner should
be thoroughly familiar with these
complications.

Full information regarding the
spray mixtures may be obtained
from the office of the Lane County
Agricultural Agent.

Thorough application is neces-
sary, regardless of the spray pro-
gram followed. To prevent worm
injury, the foliage should be cov-
ered as well as the entire surface
of every apple and pear.

Special care should be taken in
spraying the upper portion of the
tree as more than half of the cod-
ling moth eggs are laid in the up-
per third of the trees.

from the Portland Rose Show by
Mrs. Charles M. Anderson and
Mrs. Irvin Betzel.

The two women drove to Port-
land Thursday morning with their
display and came back Thursday
evening. Dr. A. H. Norton, who
had gone earlier by train, came
back with them. He and Mrs. An-
derson served as judges for the
junior rose division.

Mrs. Betzel won three ribbons
for first prizes, two seconds, two
thirds, one special award, and the
silver trophy of the Royal Rose-
society, "Peace." In winning this award,
the rose entered by Mrs. Betzel
competed with three dozen others.

Mrs. Anderson won the Port-
land Rose Society's Merit Plaque,
a silver trophy for the best vase
of five roses in the show. This was
"Saturia," the rose of the year of
the Eugene Rose Society. She also
received eight first prize ribbons,
seven seconds and eight thirds, and
a special award.
