EVERETT — (AP)—Tiny Mary Bernice Williams, who lost a mother's care on a narrow cliff-side ledge, had two offers of a new home Tuesday from distant parts of the United States.

Mary, 4, is slowly recovering in Providence Hospital from effects of a brutal beating and 17-hour exposure on the ledge where she lay by the bludgeoned body of her mother.

Her father, Wayne L. Williams, 31, is confined in jail on a murder "holding charge." Sheriff Tom Warnock said Williams admitted in a signed statement that he beat his wife, Hallie Lucille, 27, to death with rocks, beat the child and rolled their bodies over a cliff.

Warnock said the offers of adoption came from Joe P. Campbell of Augusta, Ga., and Mrs. Bertha J. Villines, Chicago.
