Loyalty Check Goes With Draft

WASHINGTON — (AP) — All youths drafted under the new peacetime conscription law will be given an FBI loyalty check—but that won't keep Communists and others of questionable loyalty from military service.
Army general staff officers said Wednesday the check will be aimed at identifying Communists and other subversive elements among the youths 19 through 25 subject to the draft.
But the Army said those found to have subversive leanings will not be exempt from military service. How they will be handled has not yet been determined. They may be segregated in separate units or spread through the armed forces with a constant tab kept on them.
Meanwhile the office of selective service records said there probably will be a six-weeks lag between the time President Truman signs the draft bill and the beginning of registrations.
All men between 18 and 25, including those in the reserves, will be required to register. But actual inductions cannot begin for 90 days after the bill is signed, unless Mr. Truman declares an emergency before then.
The President has 10 days in which to act from the time he receives the measure. He may get it later Wednesday.

State Dairymen Improving Milk
SALEM — (AP) — Oregon dairymen are improving their milk, O. K. Beals, state chief of foods and dairies, said Wednesday.
He said 641 Grade A producer-distributors or shippers were licensed in the first five months of this year. That is a 33 per cent increase, which is the result of substantial improvement in existing dairies to qualify them for Grade A licenses.

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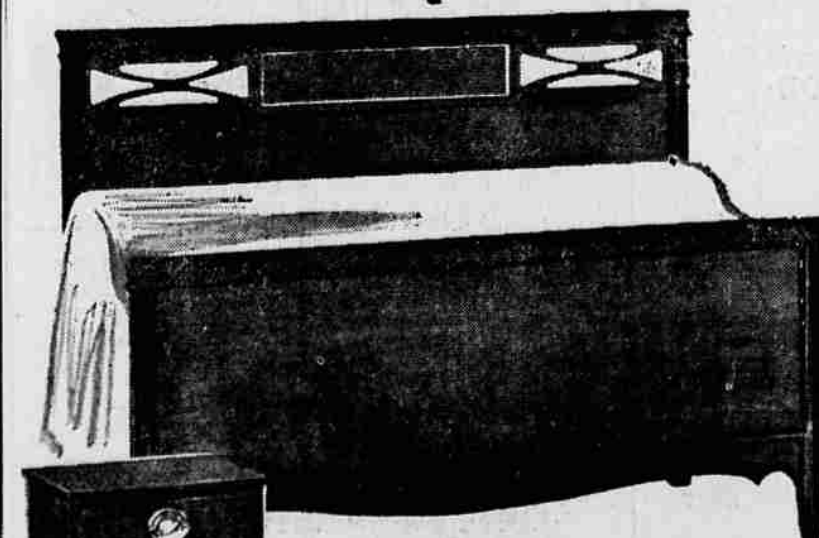
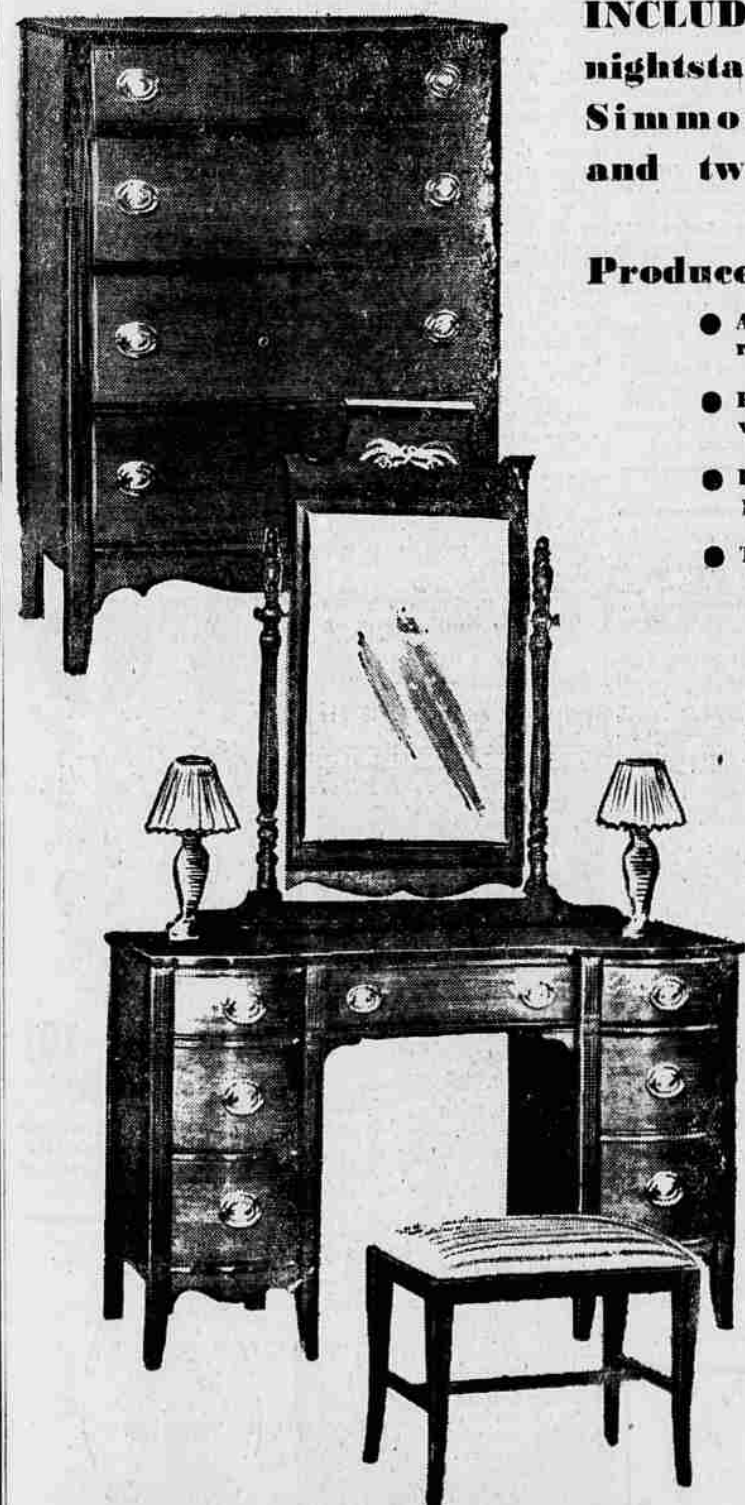
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
