

Stories Indict Jap Guard

LOS ANGELES—(AP)—A former American war prisoner has testified that Tomoya (The Meatball) Kawakita and several Japanese guards beat Americans and threw them into a cesspool.

Marcus Rael, Santa Fe, N.M., testified Thursday at the 26 year old California-born Nisei's treason trial in federal court.

Rael said he and two other prisoners were accused of stealing Red Cross supplies from the Japanese prison camp where Kawakita was a wartime interpreter.

"They dragged us to the edge of an open cesspool and beat us," he said. "Kawakita hit me several times in the face with his fist."

"Then they threw us into the pool, dragged us out and knocked us back in again. They did that about five times."

Former Pvt. David R. Carrier, Corpus Christi, Tex., testified he was forced to clean the mud from Kawakita's boots on rainy days. On cross-examination he said he didn't know whether at times Kawakita was merely translating commands from a Japanese sergeant.

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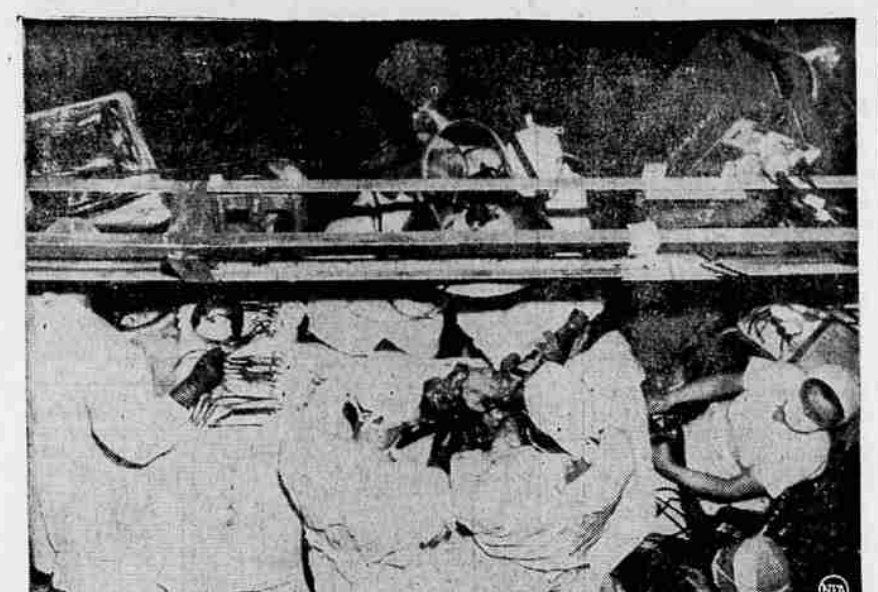

Burrell Gives Realtors Tips On Watching Money, Pricing

Members of the Eugene Realty Board were advised Thursday to watch the board of directors of the Federal Reserve System, the condition of government bonds, and the interest rate—if they wish to discover probable trends in real estate.

In a discussion on business cycles, Orrin K. Burrell of the University of Oregon school of business administration reminded realtors that real estate is closely related to interest rates, which in turn are directly influenced by actions of the board of governors in the pegging of government bonds.

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Four Timber Auctions Set

Four timber auctions are scheduled for the month of July by the Willamette National Forest Service.

The first will be held on July 12, and involves 2,500,000 board feet of salvaged Douglas fir on 600 acres of land located 20 miles northeast of Westfir. It will be known as the Christy Flat Salvage Sale, with the timber appraised at \$1 per thousand board feet.

Dry Gulch
On July 15, the Dry Gulch re-log sale will involve 1,600,000 board feet. The timber is located three miles west of McKenzie Bridge on 200 acres of land. Appraised value of the Douglas fir is \$5.70 per thousand, with the other species going for \$3.50.

One hundred seventy three acres of timber seven miles East of Idanha in the Detroit area will be auctioned off July 20. This Bruno mountain sale includes 10 million board feet with values as follows: Douglas fir, \$17.00; cedar, \$5.10; and hemlock and other species, \$3.85.

Mill Creek
The Mill Creek re-log area will be up for auction on July 21. Located three miles west of McKenzie Bridge, the 240 acres includes 3,200,000 board feet of standing timber. Most is Douglas fir, at \$5.60, with the hemlock and others appraised at \$4.40.

All auctions will be at 2 p.m. daylight saving time on the days designated in the Eugene post-office building.
