Cream, cake, coffee, strawberries and strawberry shortcake will be served. Women will bring their own and the shortcake. Anyone

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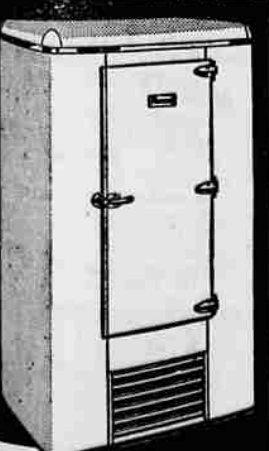

WILLAKENZIE—Grange met Saturday evening. Mr. and Mrs. A. E. Johns became members by obligation in

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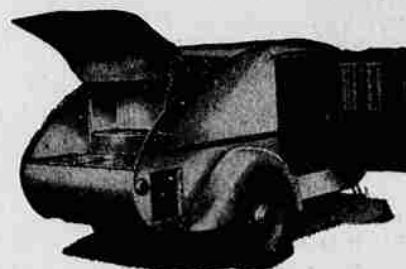
