

## Roundup Nets Gang Member

CHICAGO—(U.P.)—A peg-legged man, in whose home five guns were found, was seized here Monday as police sought to round up a gang in one of the great slum areas in Chicago history. Clarence Buehl, police chief of the Western Springs, and Chicago police arrested Jerry Buehl, 27, at his South Side home on a "tip" furnished by two women. Officers hunted three other men in the same South Side area. The police who arrested Malek included members of a force from 25 western suburbs who had used bloodhounds, planes and searchlights in an attempt to track down a gang which robbed a handbook and shot two policemen during their getaway.

Police said that persons held up Saturday in the handbook robbery told them that one of the robbers walked with a limp. Malek was seized in his bedroom without resistance. A search disclosed four shotguns and a rifle in the house, Buehl said.

## Fort Lewis To Get Additional Troops

TACOMA —(U.P.)— Sen. Harry P. Cain told the Tacoma News Tribune Monday that 21,000 troops will be moved into Fort Lewis starting Sept. 1. This is more than three times the number of troops now at the post, which had nearly 50,000 men stationed there at the end of World War II.

Cain told the Tribune in a telephone call from Washington that he had been informed of the intent to send the troops to Fort Lewis by Gen. Omar Bradley, Army chief of staff in Washington.

Movement of the troops will take in two weeks, Cain said he had been informed by Bradley. The units will consist of two divisions and supporting troops.

## Portland Police Search For Cafe Owner

PORTLAND —(U.P.)— Police searched Monday for John Bruce Wilson, 32, missing Seattle cafe owner, whose abandoned car was found in Portland with a handwritten "kidnap" note.

Wilson reportedly carried several hundred dollars with him when he disappeared from Seattle. The note told of a forced ride and robbery.

Police checked downtown hotels and air lines passenger lists without finding a trace of Wilson.

YOKOHAMA —(U.P.)—The Eighth Army military commission Monday sentenced Col. Sotaro Murata, war-time commander of all prisoners of war camps in the Osaka area, to life imprisonment at hard labor for war crimes.

Murata was convicted of causing the death of Thomas L. McGee of Lowndes, Mo., and Herbert H. Wharton of Susanville, Calif., by having them injected with poison.

Former Captain Yasuji Hori-moto, Murata's subordinate, drew a term of 40 years at hard labor.

ROSEBURG —(U.P.)— Mae Lorraine Torlos, 10, Roseburg, drowned in the South Umpqua River at the public swimming beach Sunday.

The girl was pulled from the river, but efforts of the Roseburg fire department to revive her failed.

## Nation's Funds End in Black

WASHINGTON —(U.P.)—Government bookkeepers are dipping deep into the black ink to wind up the nation's financial activities this year.

Which is to say that the treasury took in a lot more money than it spent in the past fiscal year. Among the money records set is the all-time high surplus of about \$8,000,000,000.

The fiscal year ends with the close of business Wednesday. The government, like most businesses, operates on a fiscal year beginning July 1 and ending June 30. The final figures aren't all in, but the new records look something like this:

Surplus: \$8,000,000,000.  
Peacetime income: \$45,000,000,000.

National debt payment: \$7,000,000,000.

The surplus is the second since the pre-new deal days. Last fiscal year there was a surplus of \$754,000,000. The surplus this year and last was achieved through the highest peace-time tax rates in the nation's history.

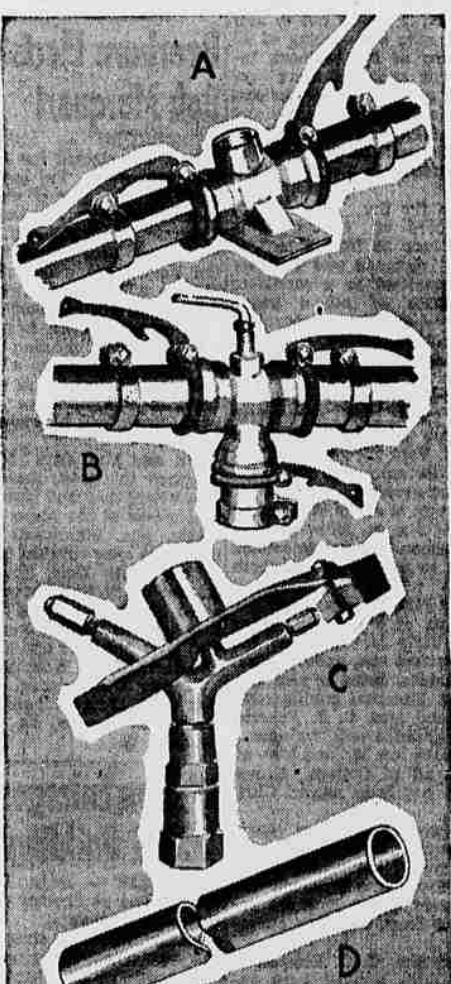
SCIENTIST JOURNEX

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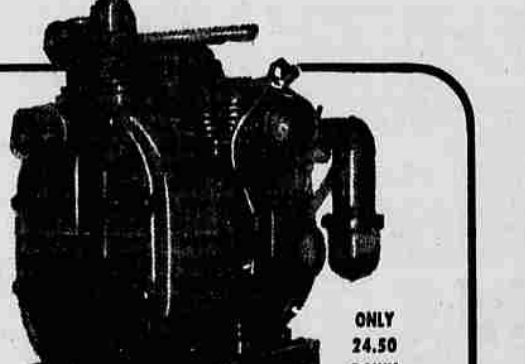

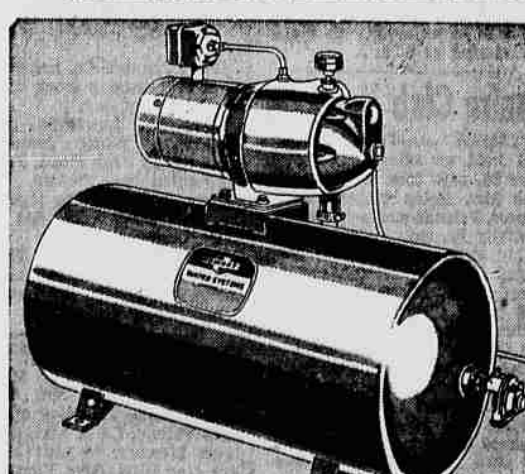
