Comic Publishers Adopt Code To Clean Up Magazines

NEW YORK — (U.P.) — The Association of Comics Magazine Publishers announced Friday the adoption of a code of editorial standards to clean up the pages of their publications which have a circulation of 50,000,000 copies monthly.

Phil Keenan, president of the newly formed association, said 14 of the 34 publishers in the industry had agreed to the following six point code:

1. Crime should not be presented in such a way as to throw sympathy against law and justice or to inspire others with the desire for imitation. No comics shall
2. No scenes of sadistic torture should be shown.
3. Sexy, wanton comics should not be published. No drawing should show a female indecently or unduly exposed and in no event more nude than in a bathing suit commonly worn in the United States.
4. Vulgar and obscene language should never be used. Slang should be kept to a minimum and used only when essential to the story.
5. Divorce should not be treated humorously nor represented as glamorous or alluring.
6. Ridicule or attack on any religious or racial group is never permissible.

Keenan, general manager of Hillman Periodicals, said that the purifying effect of the code should begin to make itself felt in about three months. He explained that the magazines are generally prepared three months in advance and that those going into production now will not be on newsstands until the first of October.

He said that the publishers had been discussing methods of cleaning up their magazines for some time. He said a determined drive was underway to enroll more of the comics publishers in the association.
