

Way Found to Save Abscessed Molars

NEW YORK — (U.P.) — Abscessed teeth can be saved now through new oral surgery techniques, Dr.

E. Alan Lieban told the American Academy of Dental Medicine. The operation is painless, he said. Under the process, drugs are introduced into the underlying tissue by electric current, sterilizing the

infected area. The root canal, which previously had been cleaned, then is filled with silver wire or gutta percha. Thus sterilized and filled, the tooth and its root may be preserved for added years of useful service, Dr. Lieban said.

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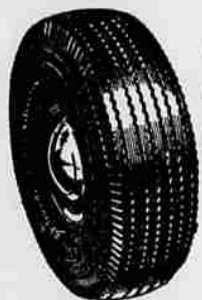


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America Goes on Big Spree With Vacations at Record

NEW YORK — (U.P.) — Americans are on the biggest vacation spree since the auto, a survey of travel agencies has revealed.

The consensus is that never before have so many Americans simultaneously packed their toothbrushes, jumped in their jalopies and uttered "to heck with it."

To be specific, about 60,000,000 Americans are doing just that. That number is almost a third again as large as last year's record 45,000,000 vacationists.

The American Automobile Association said that some 21,000,000 cars — nearly two-thirds of all those registered — will be putting down the road before the summer runs out in a mass effort to get away from it all.

Old Autos

If you think most automobiles "zoom" instead of "putt-putt," you're wrong. The association said the average trip will be endured in a nine-year-old car.

In it will be three persons who will spend about \$100 for a two-week holiday covering approximately 3000 miles.

Not all will be going to the same place, though it may seem so to each driver. A check showed that more summer vacationists will head for the west coast than any other place.

State's Court Not Through

SALEM — (U.P.) — The State Supreme Court failed Wednesday to clean up its business in order to begin its summer recess.

Wednesday was its weekly opinion day, but the high court did not hand down either of the two big cases before it.

The cases involve whether the state can use \$40,000,000 of income tax surpluses to pay state expenses; and the first degree murder appeal of Mrs. Gladys Broadhurst, who was convicted of the slaying of her husband in Malheur County.

The court held a two-hour conference Wednesday morning, presumably to iron out details in the tax case. It might hand down opinions next Friday.

Small Fry Spot Spreads to Adults

MEMPHIS, Tenn. — (U.P.) — Mrs. Elizabeth Campbell, 26-year-old mother, appeared in court with a broken nose and blackened eyes received in a brawl with a neighborhood housewife.

She even carried an envelope filled with her own hair pulled out, she said, by 35-year old Mrs. Opal Wilson.

What started it all? The little Campbell boy got a bullseye with his slingshot at Mrs. Wilson's little girl.

About 40 percent will point their radiator caps towards resorts west of the Rockies & some 25 percent will choose New England, while 16 percent light out for Florida and the Gulf coast. Ten per cent will abide their time in the north central states and 8 per cent will tour the Appalachian highlands.

That totals 99 per cent, leaving 1 per cent to get lost at various cross-roads in the country.

Thrifty This Year

Even though there will be more tourists on the road than ever before, resortmen needn't start rubbing their hands. These are thrifty tourists. They will spend about \$500,000 less this year than last.

That still will leave an estimated \$6,000,000,000 to be spent on hot-dogs, gasoline, tourist cabins and aspirin.

Not all Americans will stay in their own back yard. The Champs Elysees, London's Westminster Abbey and relaxed tourist red tape will beckon some 507,339 to Europe — only 100,000 below peak prewar years.

Ships will carry about 335,724, planes about 151,615.

For a foreign country, however, most American tourists take Canada. About 1,500,000 carloads of Americans crossed Canadian borders last year.

Mexico ranks next with American summer vacationists, then Bermuda. The fact that Bermuda is considered a winter resort by many doesn't seem to deter either the summer vacationist or the Bermuda Chamber of Commerce.

Dairymen May Utilize Ammonium Sanitizers

SALEM, Ore. — (U.P.) — Dairymen will be permitted to use quaternary ammonium sanitizers now.

They are used to kill bacteria on dairy equipment. Previously only steam, hot water and chlorine has been allowed by the State Agriculture Department.

Use of quaternary ammonium sanitizers, however, is subject to approval of the division of foods and dairies.
